NATIONAL COMMUNICATION-INC

THE INITIAL NATIONAL COMMUNICATION (INC) HAS BEEN IMPLEMENTED WITH THE TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE OF UNEP FUNDED BY GLOBAL ENVIRONMENT FACILITY (GEF) WHICH HAS BEEN SUBMITTED TO THE UNFCCC SECRETARIAT.

Priority sectors identified for the climate change concerns

Energy, Industry, Agriculture and Livestock, Land use change and forestry, and Waste sector.

MONREC is now preparing to commence the Second National Communication (SNC) project with the support of UNEP.

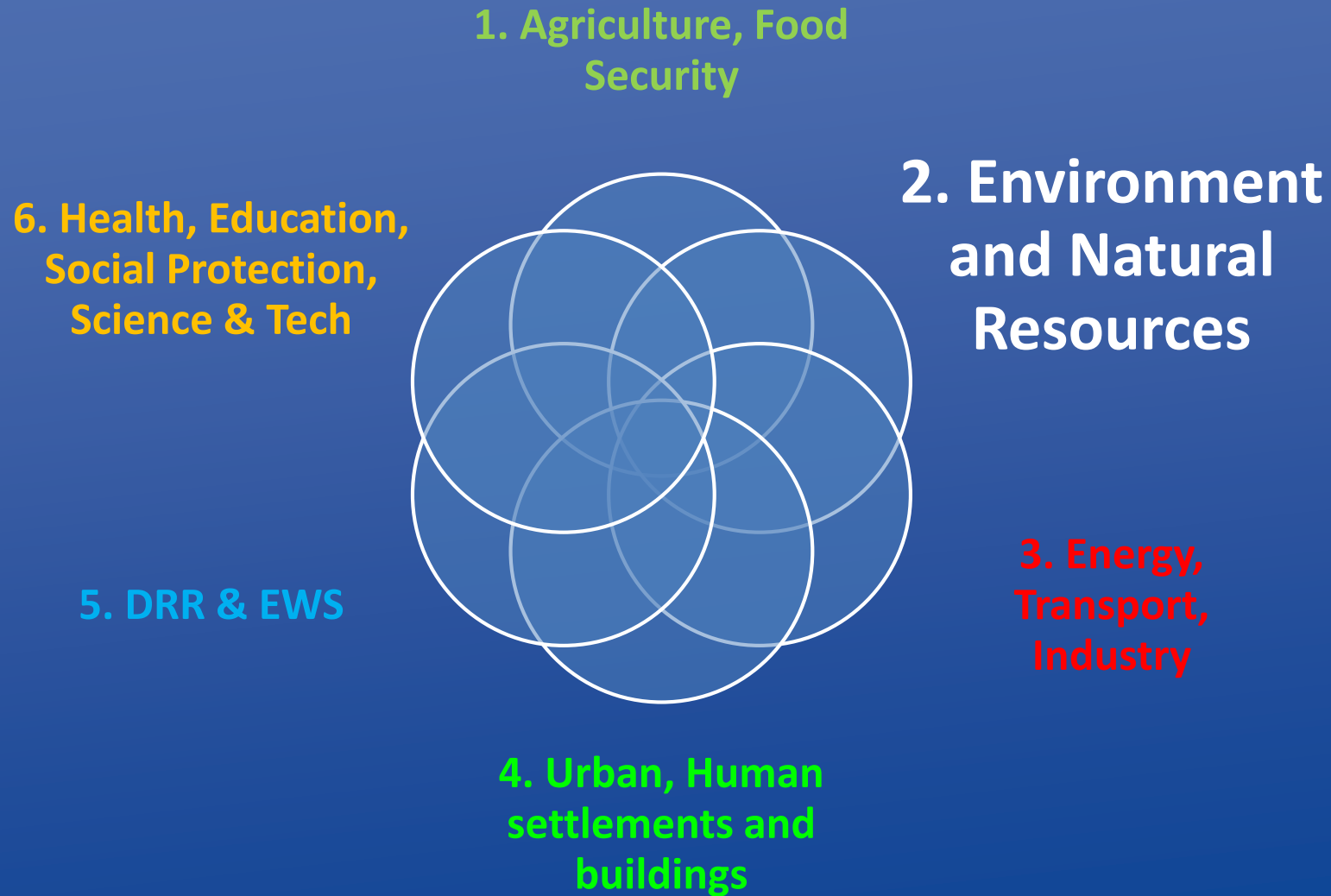


INTENDED NATIONAL DETERMINED CONTRIBUTION

- Myanmar submitted its **INDC** and participated in **COP21**.
- Mitigation objectives focused in the Myanmar INDC focused on **two main areas**:
 - **Protecting the Carbon Sink status of Myanmar through forest management with 30% Reserved Forest and 10% protected of total national land area by 2030**
 - **Increase highly the total amount and share of Renewable Energy through hydropower (i.e. mid and small) by 2030**
- In addition, several energy efficiency objectives and policy improvement on climate change and sustainable cities
- Finance and technical support are conditions for achieving the contribution

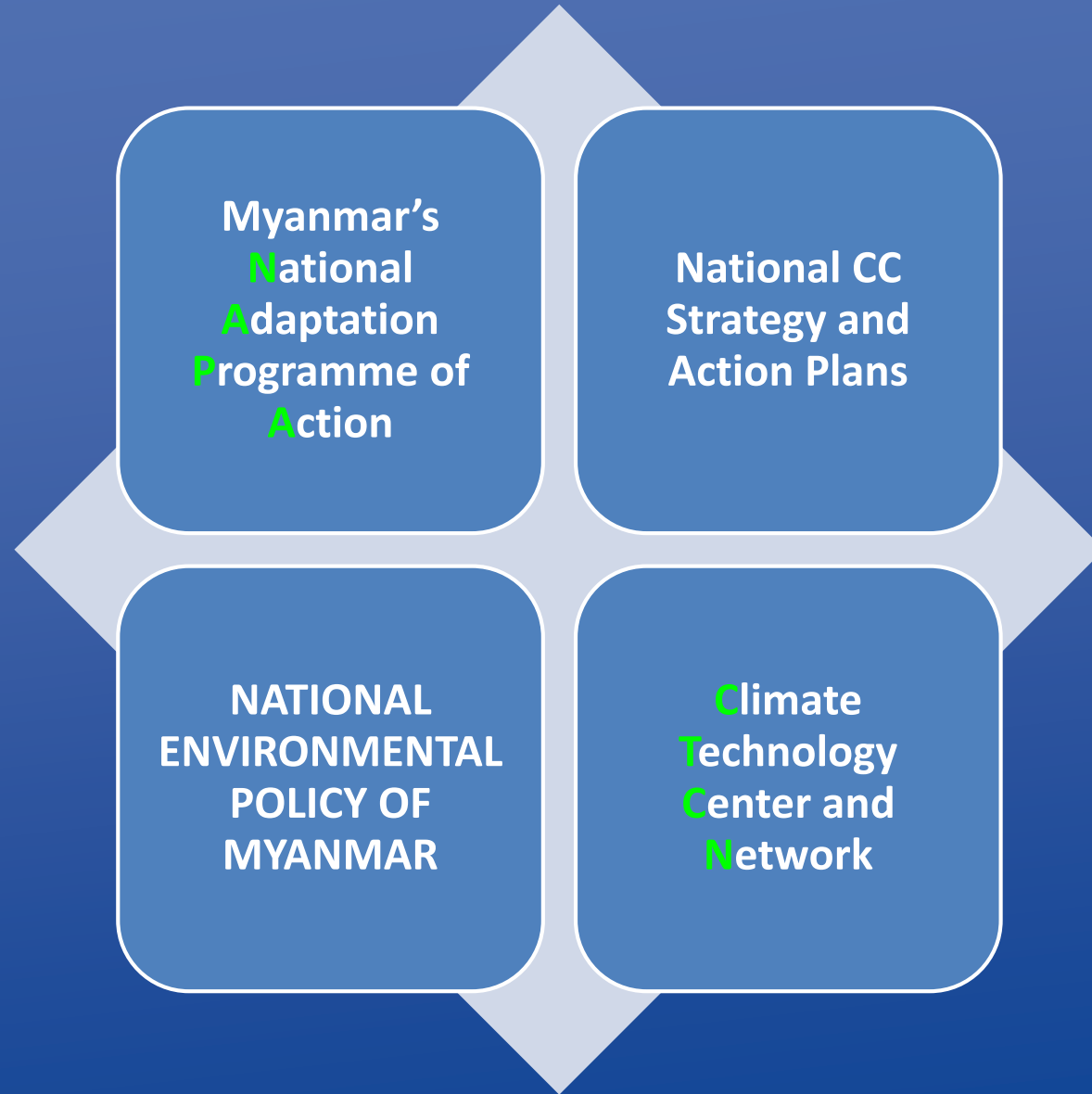

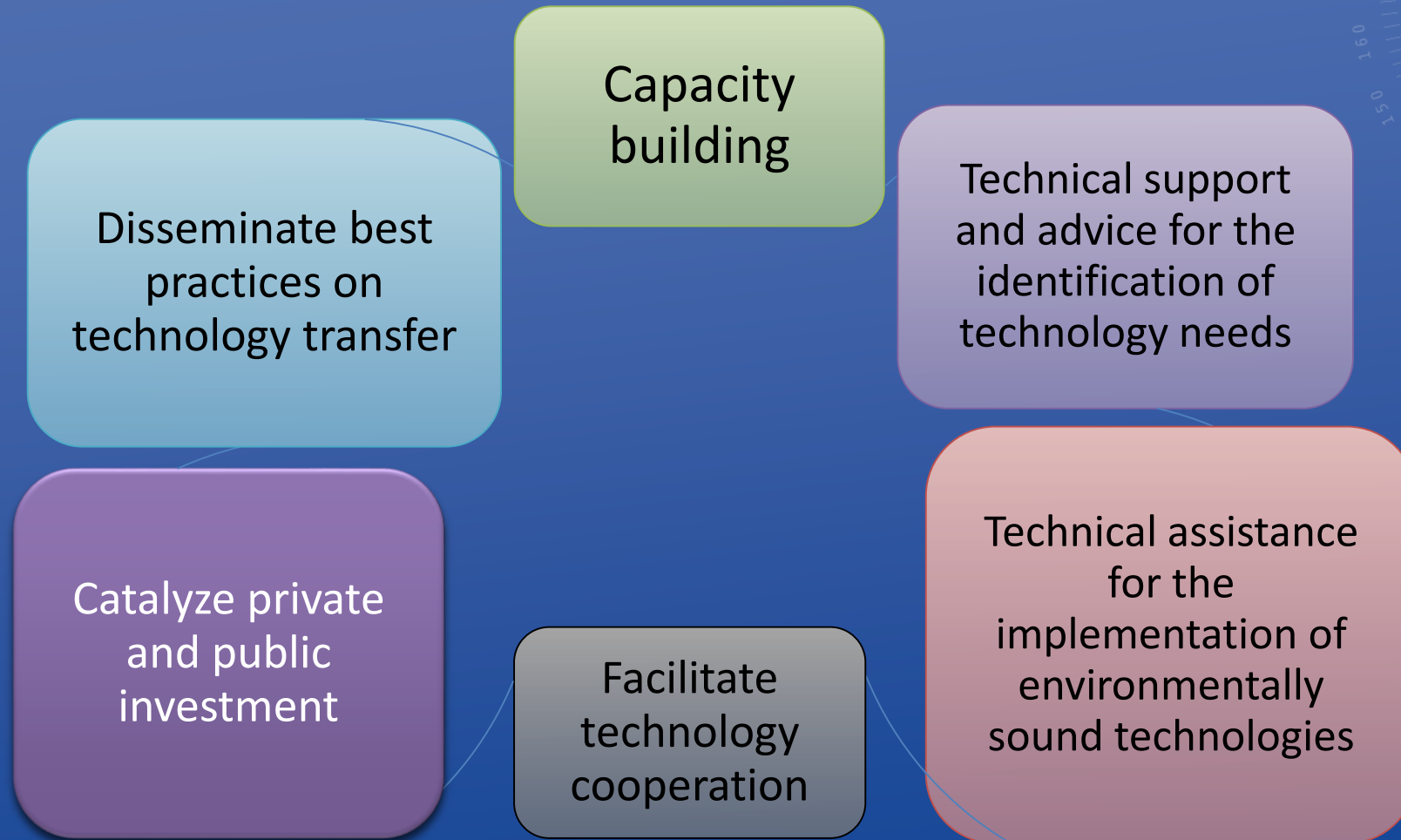
NDE OF MYANMAR
