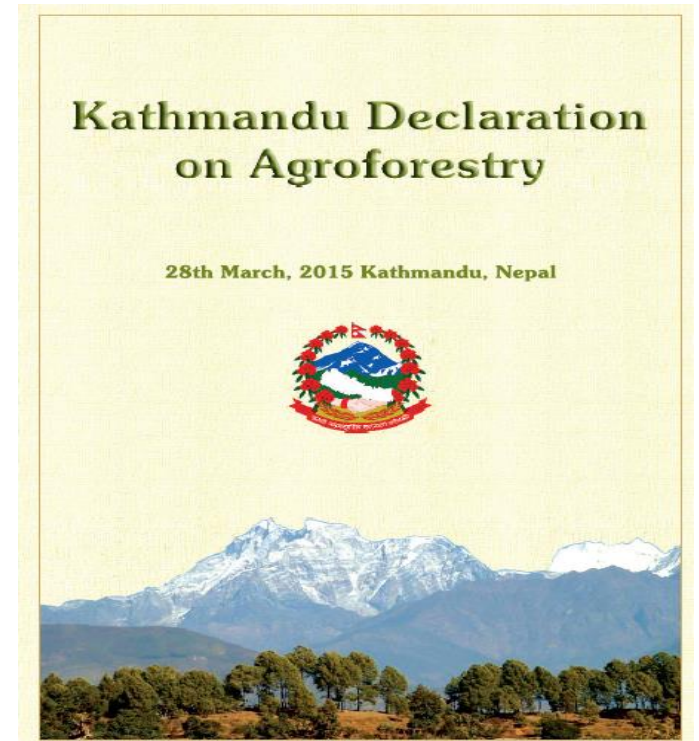

# Dialogue on Agroforestry Development started in 2014



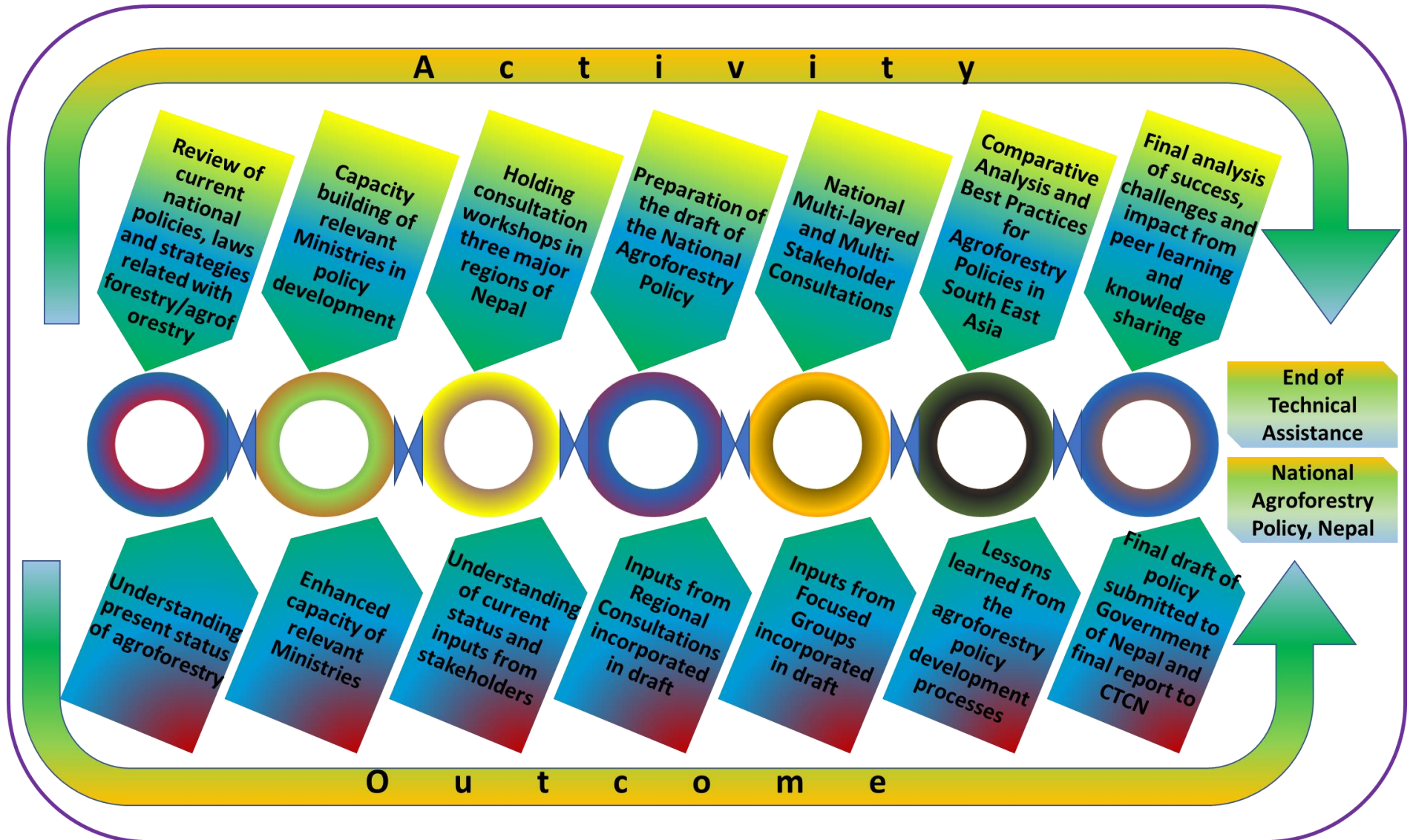
# Objective
