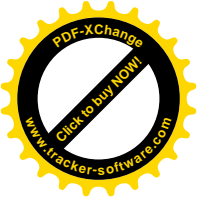
# The background and role of the Network

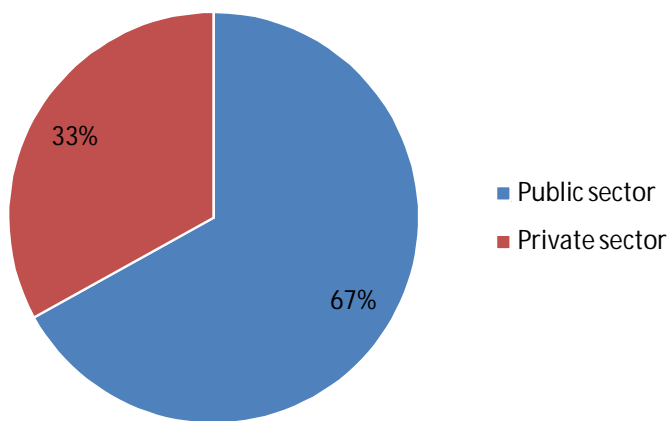




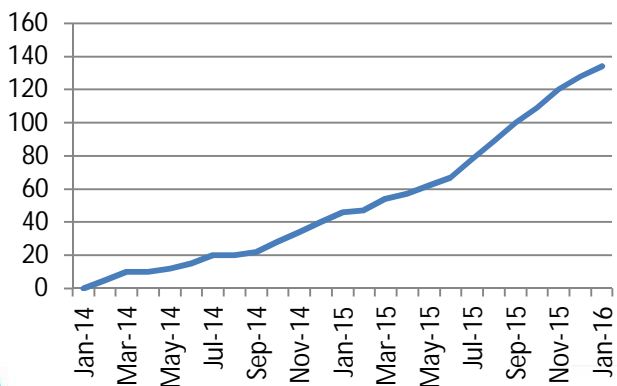
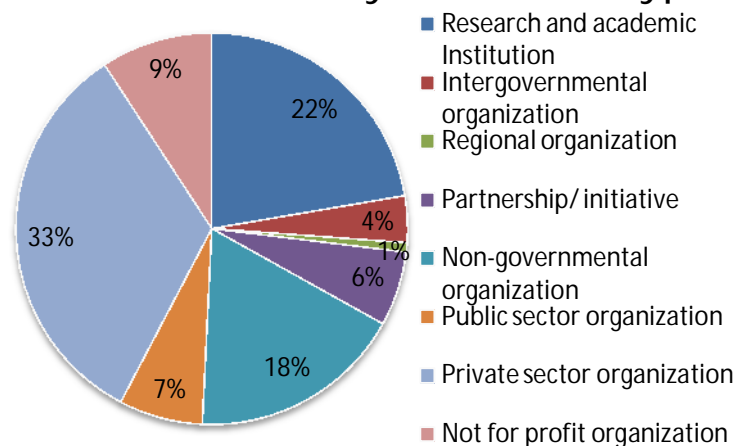
# The status of the CTC Network

- **Distribution:** 56 % from Annex 1 countries, 36 % Non-Annex 1 countries, 8 % International

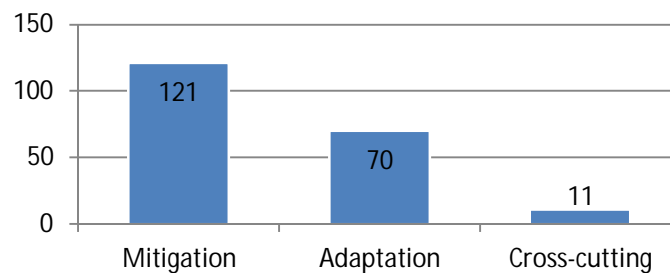
### Public vs. Private sector
