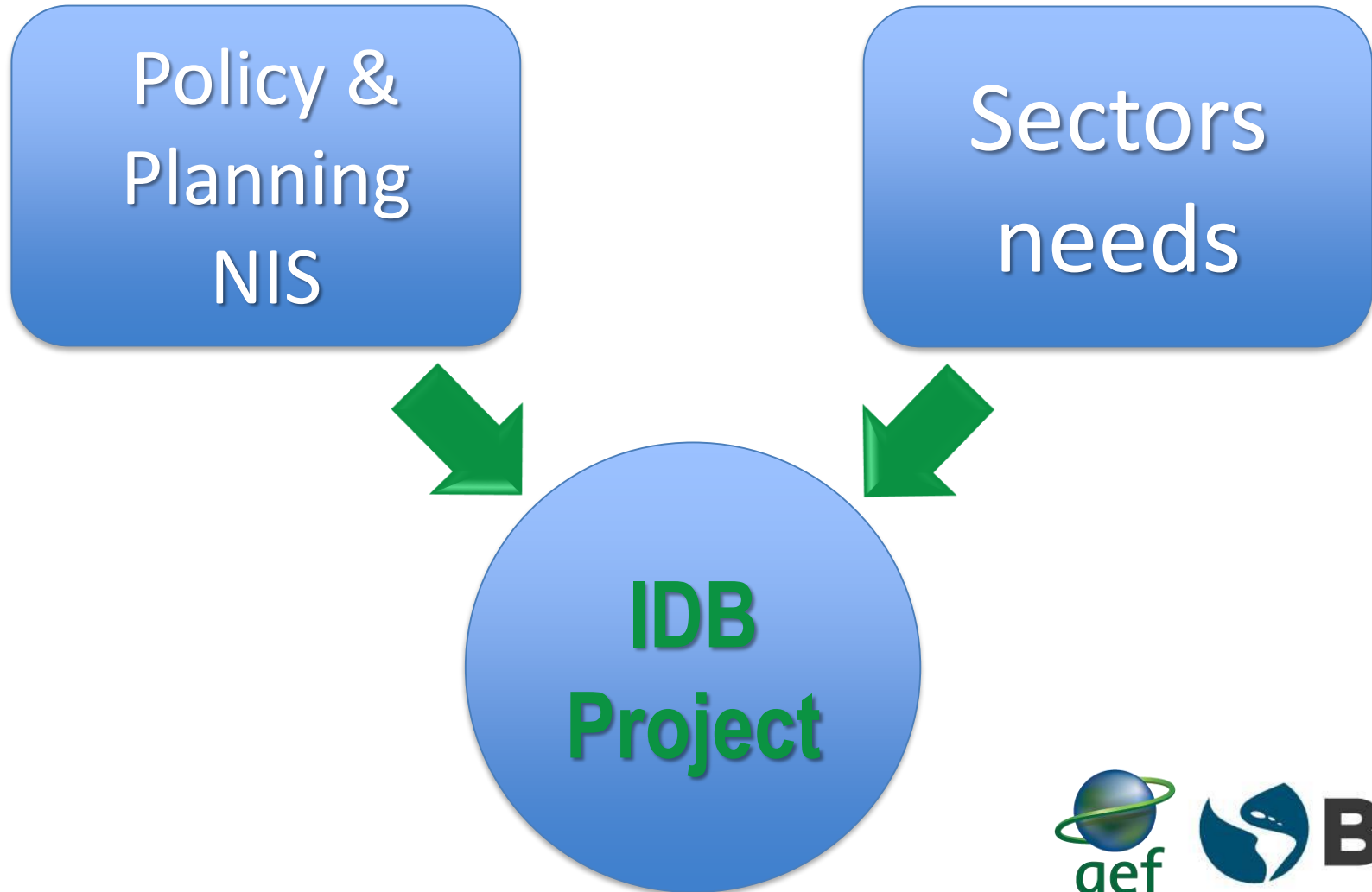
The project

- In cooperation with the UNFCCC Technology Mechanism **Climate Technology Centre and Network** (CTCN)

2 approaches:



The project

- Promote the development and transfer of **environmentally sound technologies** (EST) in LAC, to reduce GHG emissions and vulnerability to CC in specific sectors.
- Technical assistance to access and adopt technologies in 4 sectors and 1 transversal area.
- Activities started June 2015 - finalizing during 2019
