Technology in the Outcome of the First Global Stocktake under the Paris Agreement (Decision 1/CMA.5)



Technology Implementation Programme (TIP)

Established by 1/CMA.5, para 110

- Supported by, inter alia, the operating entities of the Financial Mechanism to:
 - Strengthen support for the implementation of technology priorities identified by developing countries
 - Address challenges identified in the first periodic assessment of the Technology Mechanism
- SBI 61 to consider TIP with a view to recommending a draft decision for consideration and adoption by CMA 6

Note: At SB 60, the COP 29 incoming Presidency convened an informal discussion with Parties on the TIP



Linkages between the Technology Mechanism and the Financial Mechanism (Decision 10/CP.28)



Linkages between the Technology Mechanism and the Financial Mechanism

- Invited Parties, UNFCCC constituted bodies, the operating entities of the Financial Mechanism and other relevant stakeholders to **submit their views** on maintaining and enhancing collaboration and cooperation between the Mechanisms
- Requested the secretariat to prepare a **synthesis report** of the submissions
- Requested the TEC and CTCN, in consultation with the SBI Chair, to organize an **in-session workshop at SBI 60**
- Requested the TEC, in consultations with the CTCN, to prepare a **summary report** of the workshop
- Requested **SBI 60 to initiate discussions** with a view to recommending a draft decision for consideration and adoption COP 29



Linkages between the Technology Mechanism and the Financial Mechanism

- **Feb 2024:** Submissions from 11 Parties & Groups of Parties on behalf of 169 Parties and various observer constituencies and organizations
- **Mar 2024:** Synthesis report on submissions published by the UNFCCC secretariat, available [here](#)
- **Jun 2024:** SBI 60 in-session full-day workshop with 200 participants, recording and presentations, available [here](#)
- **Jun 2024:** SBI 60 initiated discussions based on submissions, synthesis report and in-session workshop, forwarded draft text to SBI 61, available [here](#)
- **Sep 2024:** TEC to finalize workshop report at TEC 29
- **Oct 2024:** Workshop report to be published by the UNFCCC secretariat

What is the JAR about?

- TEC and CTCN jointly submit an annual report (JAR) to the COP and CMA through the SBI and SBSTA
- Report highlights TEC and CTCN performance, activities and challenges in responding to mandates by the COP and CMA
- COP and CMA provide guidance to the Technology Mechanism

JAR 2023

- Welcomed progress of implementation joint work programme and enhanced coordination, the engagement with NDEs
- Noted the Technology Mechanism Initiative on AI for Climate Action
- Commended efforts to mainstream gender consideration
- Welcomed the finalization of the resource mobilization and partnership strategy for 2023-2027
- Acknowledged the role of the CTCN Partnership and Liaison Office
