Membership arrangements of the CTCN Advisory Board

1. Legislative basis

- a. 14/CP.18 (Annex II containing the CTCN AB RoP);
- b. 25/CP.19;
- c. 10/CP.26

2. Compositions

30 representatives

- 9 government representatives from Annex I Parties
- 9 government representatives from Non-Annex I Parties
- Chair/Vice-Chair, Co-chair, or a designated representative of the Adaptation Committee, Green Climate Fund, Global Environment Facility, Standing Committee on Finance, and Technology Executive Committee, respectively
- Director of the CTCN
- 6 observer organizations representatives, one each from the UNFCCC observer organization constituencies (ENGOs, BINGOs, IPOs, RINGOs, WGCs, and YOUNGOs)

3. Member term of office / capacity in which they serve:

- Serve as representative of their constituency
- Term of office: 2 years
- Max. no of terms to serve in office: 2 consecutive terms of 2 years
- Half of government representatives elected for an initial term of 3 years and half of the members elected for an initial term of 2 years, thereafter, COP shall elect half of the representatives every year for a term of 2 years

4. Member eligible for re-election:

- Yes, members can serve a maximum of 2 consecutive terms of 2 years
- Rule 5 of the CTCN AB RoP: *"Government representatives elected to the Advisory Board shall serve for a term of two years and shall be eligible to serve a maximum of two consecutive terms of office."*

5. Nomination required for election and for re-election:

- Yes, nominations required the respective constituencies.
- Rule 4: *"Government representatives shall be nominated by their respective groups or constituencies and elected by the {COP}."*

6. Current member remains in office if there is no nomination:

- Yes, member can remain in office.
- Rule 5 (c): *"The members shall remain in office until their successors are elected."*
