# I. AC Engagement with the Technology Mechanism

---

- The **Adaptation Committee (AC)** is in regular contact with the other adaptation-related constituted bodies and processes to discuss collaborative opportunities.
- The AC was pleased to welcome a **representative of the TEC** at our **26<sup>th</sup> meeting** in September 2024.
- A conference call between the AC and the TEC took place on August 22, 2024, to discuss **potential areas of collaboration**, including:
  - Collaboration opportunities with the CTCN based on the CTCN experience of providing technical assistance and training to countries;
  - The AC participation in National Designated Entities (NDEs) Forum in 2025 organized by the CTCN

## II. Opportunities for collaboration

---

- ❖ The AC also noted the activities of the rolling workplan of TEC for 2023-2027 related to addressing developing countries' capacity gaps in accessing adaptation funding (Activity A.1.2. and A.2.2) and other adaptation related activities (Activity A.3.1; D.1.1; C.2.1) as avenues for further collaboration.
- ❖ From the [CTCN Third Programme of Work for 2023-2027](#), there could be scope for inputs or review from the AC side, if invited, on activities pertaining:
  - ❖ **Water-Energy-Food Nexus**, including technologies related to crop resilience and improved water management.
  - ❖ **Buildings and Infrastructure**, including sustainable infrastructure as an opportunity to integrate adaptation strategies into development;
  - ❖ **Digitalization** (such as freely available and open-source software, data, and standards) to enable the design of policies that support climate risk assessments, planning for adaptation and resilience;
  - ❖ **National Systems of Innovation**, including strengthening capacities for innovation for adaptation and resilience.
