Advance gender equality and empowerment in every aspect of CTCN's operations



- i. Introduction of the Gender Assessment and Action Plan (GAAP);
- ii. 5 per cent resource allocation for gender mainstreaming activities
- iii. Development of sector-specific gender mainstreaming guidelines

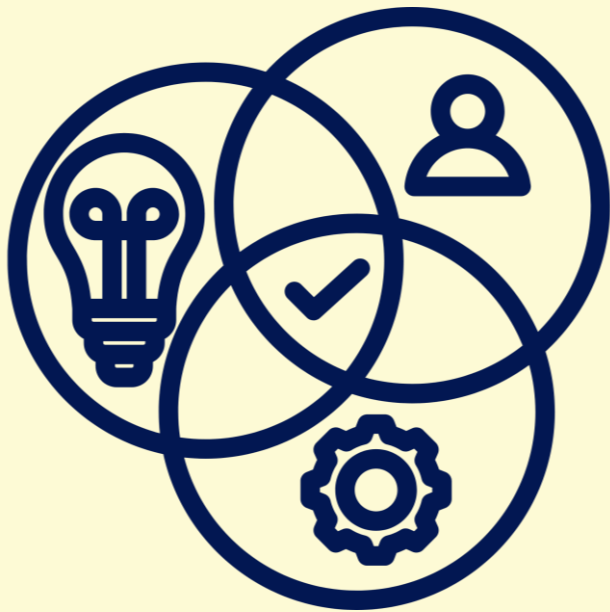
Technical Assistance: Monitoring and Evaluation

- i) **Technical Assistance Response Plan** now includes:
 - Reference to the Technology Mechanism Climate Technology and Gender Roster
 - Requirement to allocate 5% of the budget to gender-responsive activities
 - Inclusion of the Gender Assessment and Action Plan (GAAP)

- i) **Closure Reports** for each project:
 - Section for detailed reporting on gender aspects
 - Reporting on resources allocated from the 5% gender budget



Capacity Building



- i. Webinar on gender and climate technologies in the Buildings and Infrastructure sector.
- ii. Gender-mainstreaming agenda items and/or training sessions at:
 - Regional forums
 - Subsidiary Bodies (SBs) meetings
 - COP and other climate technology events.

Networking and Partnership

- i. Include the **CTCN Gender Policy and Action Plan** during Network member onboarding;
- ii. Promote the **Technology Mechanism Climate Technology and Gender Roster** with a communication campaign;
- iii. Collaborate on the **9th edition of the Gender Just Climate Solutions** publication with Women Engaged for a Common Future and the Women and Gender Constituency;



Knowledge Sharing and Communication



- i. **Information dissemination** with regular updates of online tools and publications on gender and climate change via the CTCN web platform.
- ii. **Best practices sharing** to promote gender, indigenous knowledge, and climate technology best practices through the web platform, social media, and events.
- iii. **Resource development** to provide fact sheets, guidelines, manuals, and sectoral overviews to address gender considerations in various climate technology sectors.
