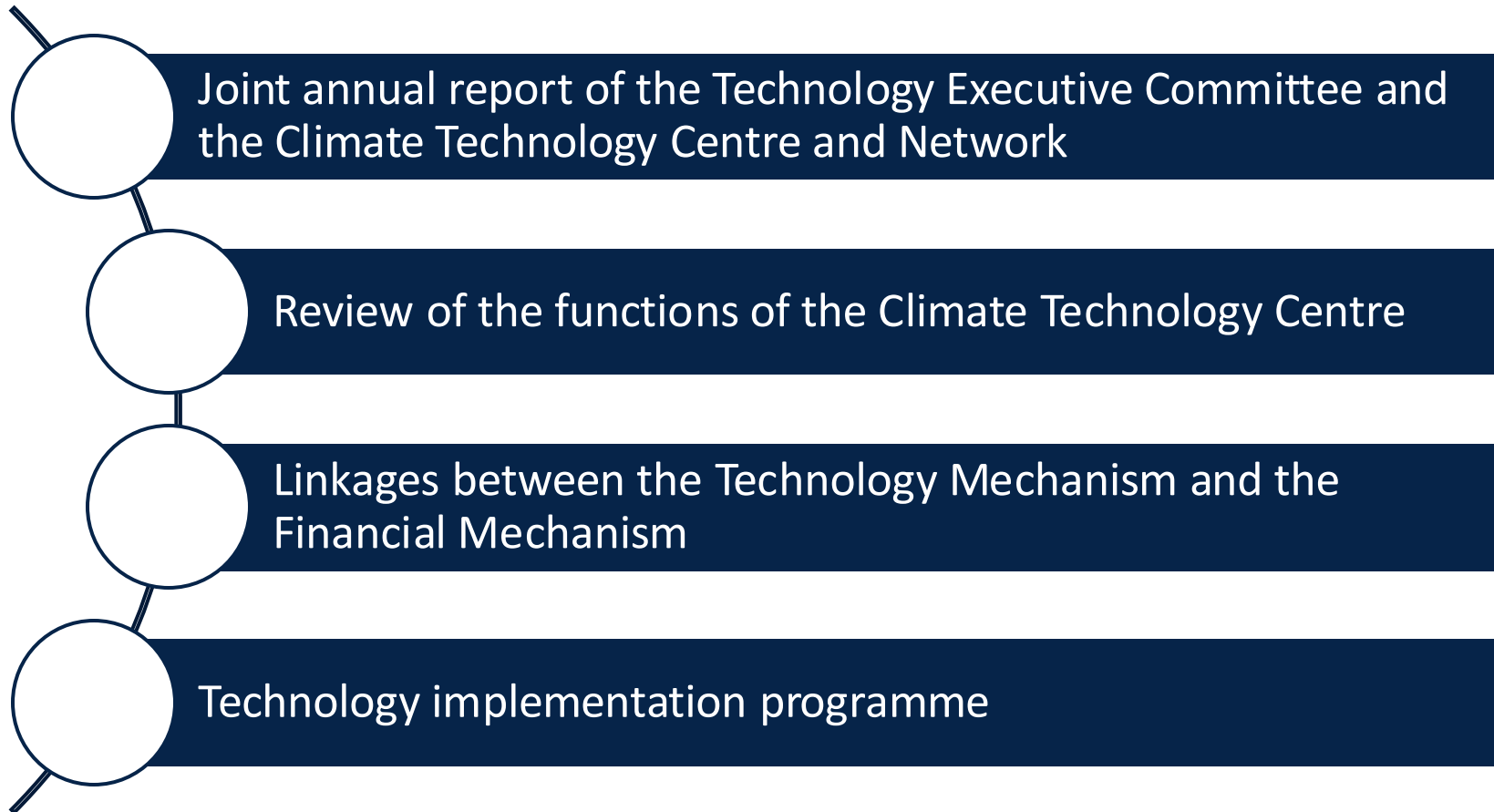

# Outlook for the Belém Climate Change Conference of November

## Joint annual report of the Technology Executive Committee and the Climate Technology Centre and Network

### Decision 2/CP.17

**Para 142.** Requests the Technology Executive Committee and the Climate Technology Centre to establish procedures for preparing a joint annual report;

**Para 143.** Also requests the secretariat to make available the joint annual report referred to in paragraph 142 above for consideration by the Conference of the Parties through its subsidiary bodies;

### Decision 1/CP.21,

**Para 68.** Decides that the Technology Executive Committee and the Climate Technology Centre and Network shall report to the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement, through the subsidiary bodies, on their activities to support the implementation of the Agreement;

### Decision 15/CP.22

**Para 6.** Invites the Technology Executive Committee and the Climate Technology Centre and Network to include information in the respective chapters of their future joint annual reports on challenges and lessons learned in implementing their respective mandates;

## Review of the functions of the Climate Technology Centre

### Decision 10/CP.29 (Nov 2024)

**Para. 3:** Decides to conduct a review of the functions and decide whether to extend the term of the Climate Technology Centre at COP 30 (Nov 2025).

**Para. 4:** Requests SBI 62 (June 2025) to initiate the review with a view to recommending a draft decision to COP 30 (Nov 2025).

### SBI62

SBI agreed to continue consideration of the matter at SBI 63.

Consider the selection criteria.



# Outlook for the Belém Climate Change Conference of November 2025

## Linkages between the Technology Mechanism and the Financial Mechanism

At SBI 60 an **in-session workshop** was organized to take stock of the linkages between the Technology Mechanism and the Financial Mechanism taking into account the views expressed in **the submissions**, and a discussion was initiated on the **submissions, synthesis report and workshop** with a view to recommending a draft decision thereon for consideration and adoption at COP 29.

At SBI 61/COP29, Parties agreed to continue consideration at SBI 62.

The SBI agreed to continue consideration of this matter at SBI 63 on the basis of the draft text available on the UNFCCC website

## Technology Implementation Programme

Decision 1/CMA.5 on the outcome of the first global stocktake **established the technology implementation programme (TIP)**, supported by, inter alia, the operating entities of the Financial Mechanism, to strengthen support for the implementation of technology priorities identified by developing countries, and to address the challenges identified in the first periodic assessment of the Technology Mechanism.

CMA 6 **decided to launch a process** for elaborating the TIP and **requested SBI 62** to consider this matter based on deliberations by Parties at CMA 6, contained in a draft negotiating text, with a view to recommending a draft decision for consideration and adoption at CMA 7.

In accordance with rules 10(c) and 16 of the draft rules of procedure being applied, the matter will be included in the provisional agenda for SBI 63.



# Outcomes of the Bonn Climate Change Conference of June 2025

Item	Outcome
<b>Alignment between processes pertaining to the review of the Climate Technology Centre and Network and the periodic assessment of the Technology Mechanism</b>	At its 1st meeting, the SBI agreed to defer consideration of this matter to SBI 64 (June 2026).
