- Support development & approval of Readiness 2.0 Multi-year program
 - Approved March 2025

- Support SPREP Regional Office in Majuro
 - Developed Business Plan

 - Participated in 5 regional meetings



READINESS 2.0 PART I



- October 2025 – October 2027
- \$911,965.00 programmed (out of \$7m)
- Continued support institutional coordination and strengthening of the NDA
 - Updating NDA handbook and country program
 - Support to national climate change coordinating committee meetings
- Continued support to Ministry of Finance accreditation
- Support development of sector adaptation plans
- Feasibility study on mobilizing RMI private sector in climate finance
- Pipeline development – Energy sector



READINESS 2.0 PART II



- Programming of remaining Readiness Multi-year program of \$6m
- Formally approached SPREP in September 2025
- \$3m for NAP and NDC 3.0 support
 - NbS assessment for selected atolls
 - Support to set up Center of Excellence (COE)
- \$3m for NDA Strengthening
 - Continued support to accreditation
 - Continued support to coordination
 - Explore technology needs assessment
