COP 30 AGENDA ITEMS ON TECHNOLOGY

➤ Linkages between Technology Mechanism and Financial Mechanism

DECISION

- ❑ There was no decision due to lack of agreement on issues. It was proposed that Rule 16 would apply, but with the request from the G77 and China technology negotiators negotiations will be based on the Belem text in Bonn

MAIN ISSUE

- ❑ Developed countries want linkages to be discussed under the JAR agenda Item, not as a stand-alone item. Developing countries want it to remain a substantive item on the COP agenda

WHY?

- ❑ Developing countries want more engagement between the TM and the FM in order to mobilise adequate and accessible finances for climate technologies

➤ **Joint Annual Report (JAR) of the Technology Executive Committee (TEC) and the Climate Technology Center and Network (CTCN)**

DECISION

Due to disagreement on the sources of funding, the enhanced function of the CTCN, the role of developed countries in accordance with the CBDR there was no decision text. There was a proposal to apply Rule 16 in the conclusion, but after further discussions Parties agreed to continue discussion/negotiations in June, Bonn based on the Belem text

MAIN ISSUE

- ❑ The implementation role of the CTCN claimed by developing countries, developed countries want to maintain the current facilitation role of the CTCN and not to add any more function

WHY?

- ❑ Developing countries want that the CTCN assists countries beyond the facilitation role to have fundable projects

➤ **Technology Implementation Programme (TIP)**

DECISION

- ❑ **The proposal to undertake the operationalisation of Belém Technology Implementation Programme was accepted and a draft decision was agreed on. This means parties now have the obligation to unpack the implications of operationalisation of TIP starting from Bonn in June 2026**

MAIN ISSUES

- ❑ **Framework, Objectives, Component, Governance, Operational modalities**
 - ❑ **Finance issues**
 - ❑ **Implementation role of the CTCN**

➤ CTCN functions review and host selection

DECISION

- ❑ It was agreed to enhance the functions of the CTCN beyond the Technical Assistance (TA), by formalising the match-making rôle. It was also agreed that the process to select the host of the CTCN with its enhanced functions should start. I was nominated to be a member of the Selection Committee.

MAIN ISSUES

- ❑ Matchmaking of the CTCN
 - ❑ Implementation role,
 - ❑ Finance issues
- ❑ Assistance till fundable projects
