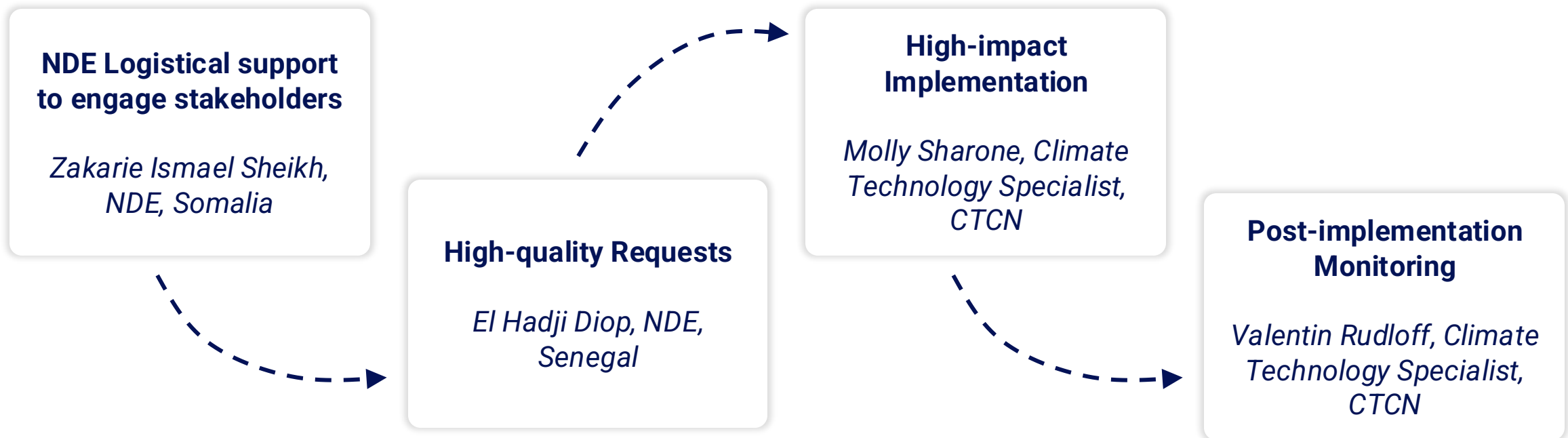
Workshop Tour explained
