The World Café sessions bring NDEs together to explore proven and emerging climate technologies across key system transformation areas.

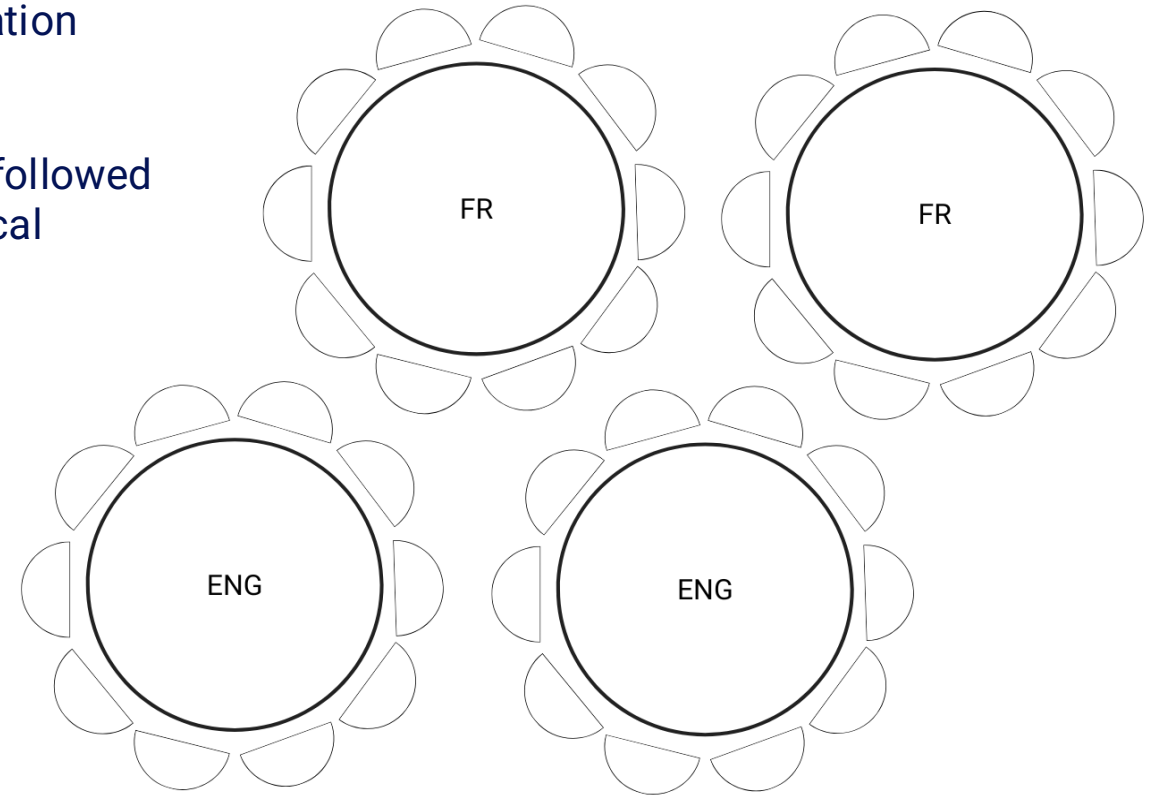
Each session starts with a short presentation by a facilitator, followed by moderated small-group discussions that encourage practical exchange, peer learning, and shared insights.

Workshop Format

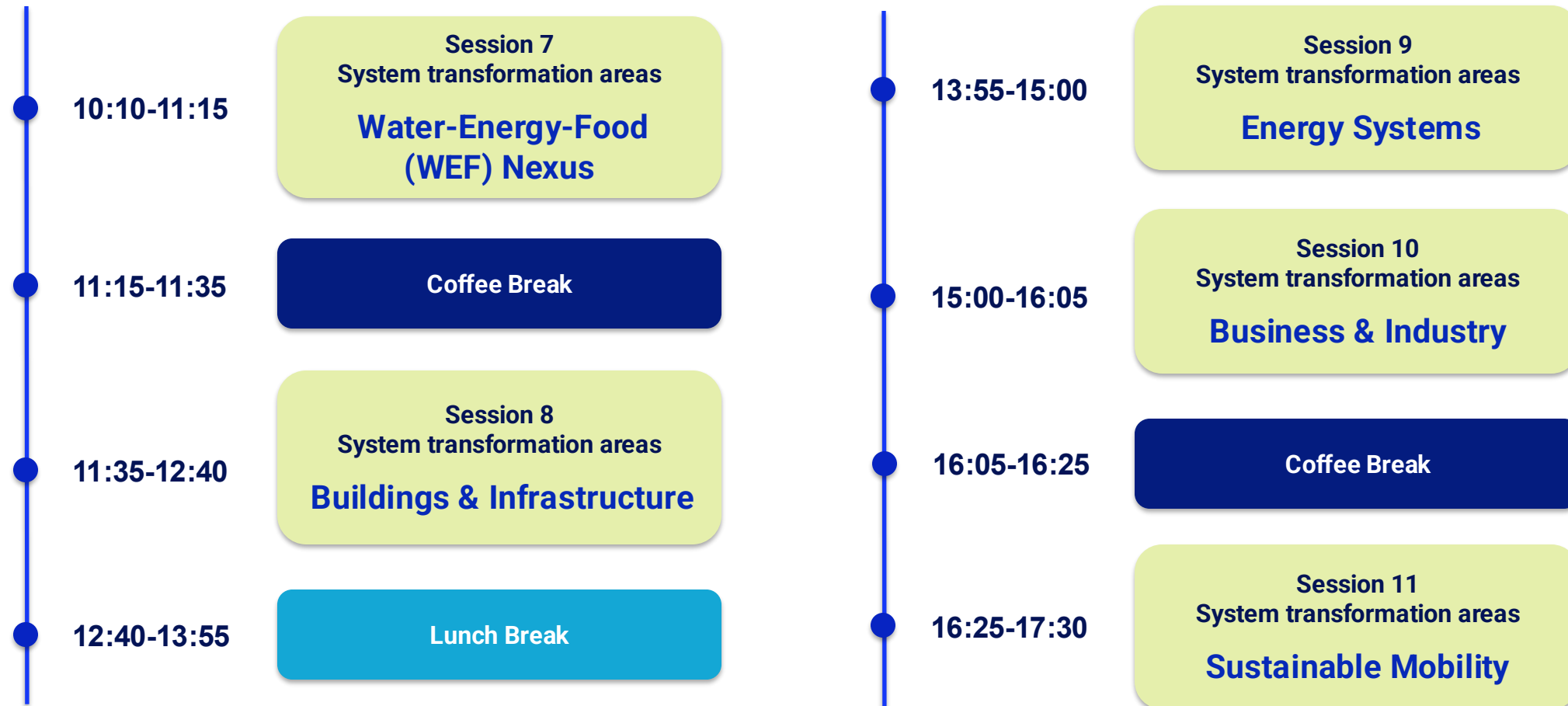
- Participants divided into 4 groups (≈10 pax per table)
