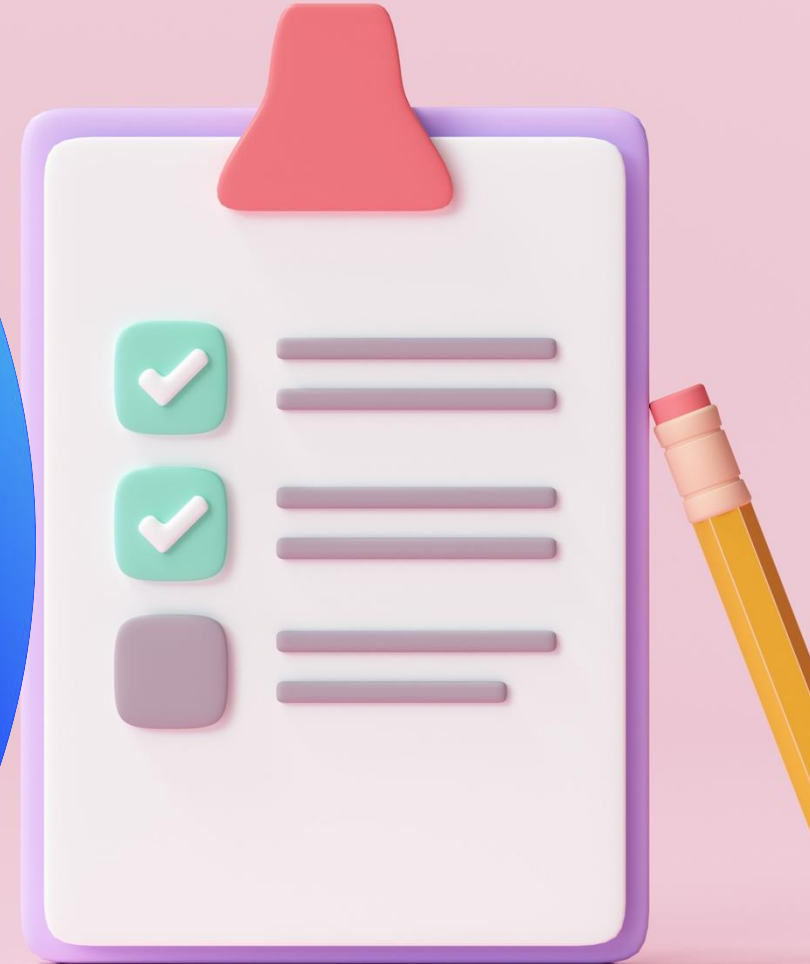

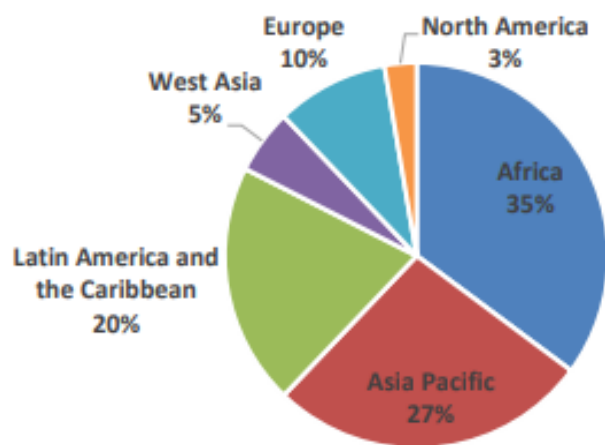

- Launch of the NDE survey before the first NDE forum of the year and with dedicated slots at each of the NDE forums in Africa, LAC, and Asia

Actions taken

- NDE survey methodology, timeline, and outreach plan were presented at joint M&E activity group
- March: Translate survey questions in three languages

Next steps

- March ~ July Launch survey in March, implement communication and outreach strategy, and collect responses until 30 July
- Analyze results and report findings in 2026 Joint AnnualReport and TEC 33/ CTCN AB 28
