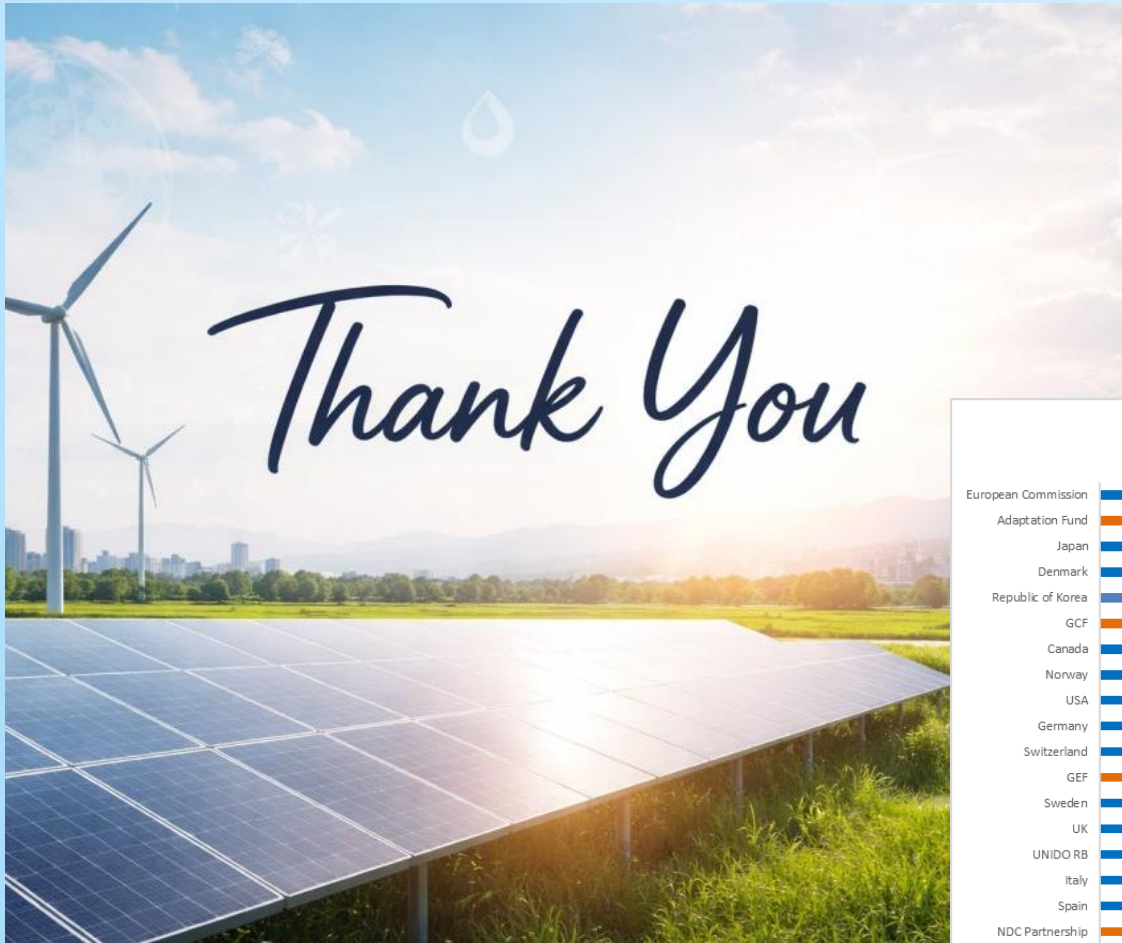

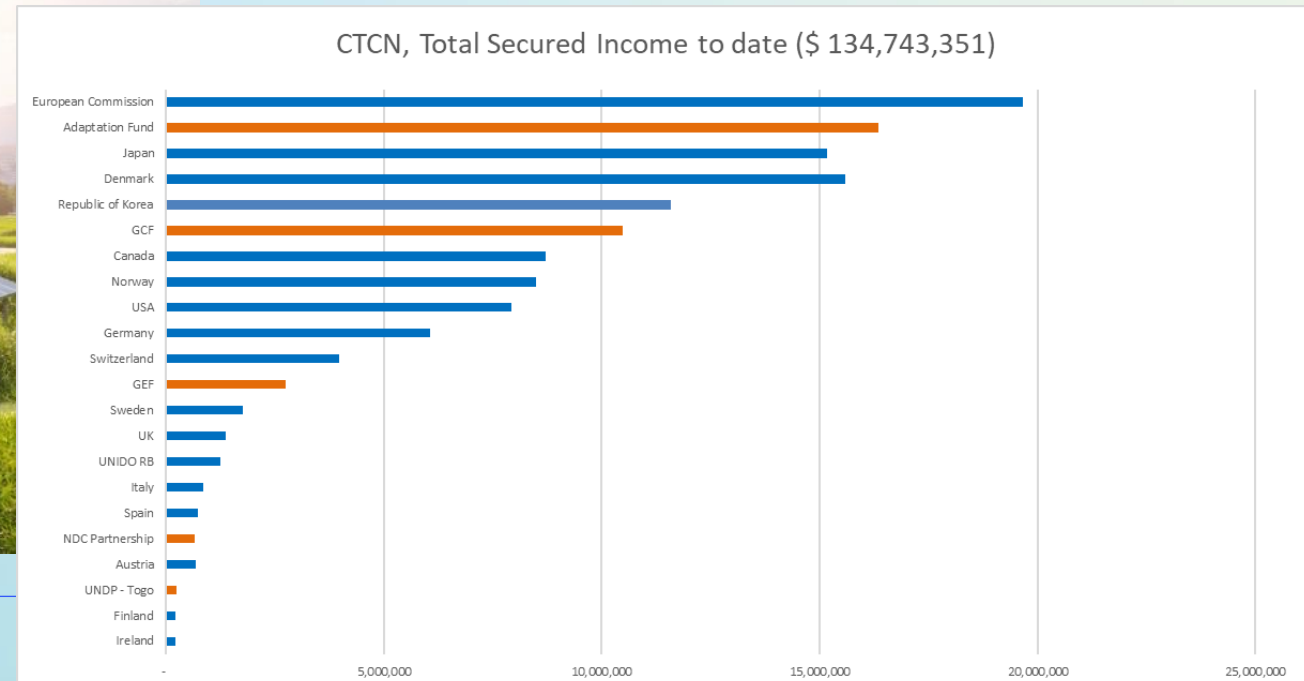

Strategic Action 1: Sustain, strengthen and diversify engagement with donor Parties



- In 2025 new commitments from Japan, RoK, Spain, Canada, Austria, Germany, Sweden
- Until new hosting arrangement has been announced, new pledges are difficult to materialize



Strategic Action 2: Enhance and diversify engagement with development financing sources and international financial institutions

- **Kenya Commercial Bank** - CTCN signed an MoU with Kenya Commercial Bank, the full project proposal was submitted to GCF for consideration on 1 September 2025, and F292 Scaling climate-smart solutions for hardest-to-reach MSMEs and farmers in Kenya (USD 43.6m) has been approved at GCF B44 in March 2026.
- **Asia Development Bank** - Ongoing discussion on potential scale-up of an ongoing TA: Enhancing weather and climate data management innovation in Tajikistan (Response Plan under development) under ADB GCF FP283 Glaciers to Farms (G2F) Regional program
- **Asia Infrastructure Investment Bank** - Ongoing discussion on potential scale-up of a completed TA on Green Hydrogen under AIIB GCF
- **Bank of China** – Ongoing discussion on potential scale-up of TAs in Asia and Central Asia

Strategic Action 2: Enhance and diversify engagement with development financing sources and international financial institutions (cont.)

- **New Development Bank** – ongoing discussion on potential scale-up of TAs
- **Eurasia Development Bank** - Ongoing discussion on potential scale-up of an ongoing TA in Uzbekistan in groundwater desalination
- **Global Green Growth Institute** - Ongoing discussion on potential scale-up of a completed TA on roadmap for NDCs of Pakistan under GGGI GCF
- **Korea Development Bank** - Ongoing discussion on potential scale-up of an ongoing TA in Uzbekistan in groundwater desalination
- **Korean Ministry of Science and ICT** - KIER, for a scale-up project, will submit an application for the demonstration funding offered by MSIT for the PNG Pre-feasibility study on Ocean Energy

Strategic Action 3: Strengthen efforts to mobilize resources from the private sector and philanthropic organizations

- Novo Nordisk Foundation and International Maize and Wheat Improvement Centre (CIMMYT): CN on multi-year programme on agricultural mitigation is under consideration and was submitted to NNF on Friday.

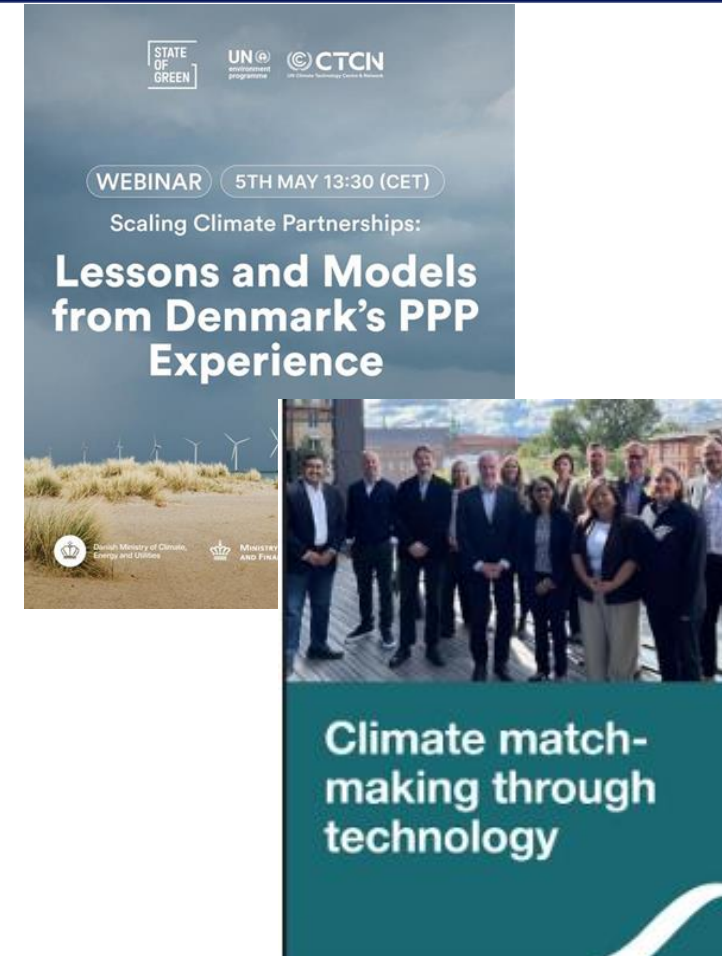

Public & Multilateral Funders

Financial backbone of CTCN.

2

Financial Institutions & Investors:

Not a core funding but essential for long-term scale and capital mobilization beyond grants.

3

Philanthropic Capital:

offers flexibility and can support innovation areas that public finance may not immediately fund.

4

Non-Profit & Network-Based Actors:

Best positioned as multipliers and co-fundraising partners rather than primary funding anchors.

5

Private Sector Corporations:

Valuable complementary channel, but unlikely to serve as primary institutional funders. Engagement should be targeted and thematic.
