RESOLUTION REORGANIZING THE QUEZON CITY DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT COUNCIL (QCDRRMC), AND REAFFIRMING WITH MODIFICATIONS TO THE COMPOSITION, AND ORGANIZATION THEREOF

CHAPTER IV  
BARANGAY FOCAL PERSON

**SECTION 9. DESIGNATION OF BARANGAY FOCAL PERSON.** – In order to gather accurate data and adequately address the needs of PWDs within the community, and to enable QC-PDAO to effectively plan and implement programs while ensuring optimal information dissemination, each barangay shall designate a Barangay Focal Person for PWDs through a barangay resolution, in coordination with QC-PDAO. The Barangay Focal Person shall preferably be a person with disability, a parent or guardian of a PWD, or an individual trained in disability-inclusive governance.



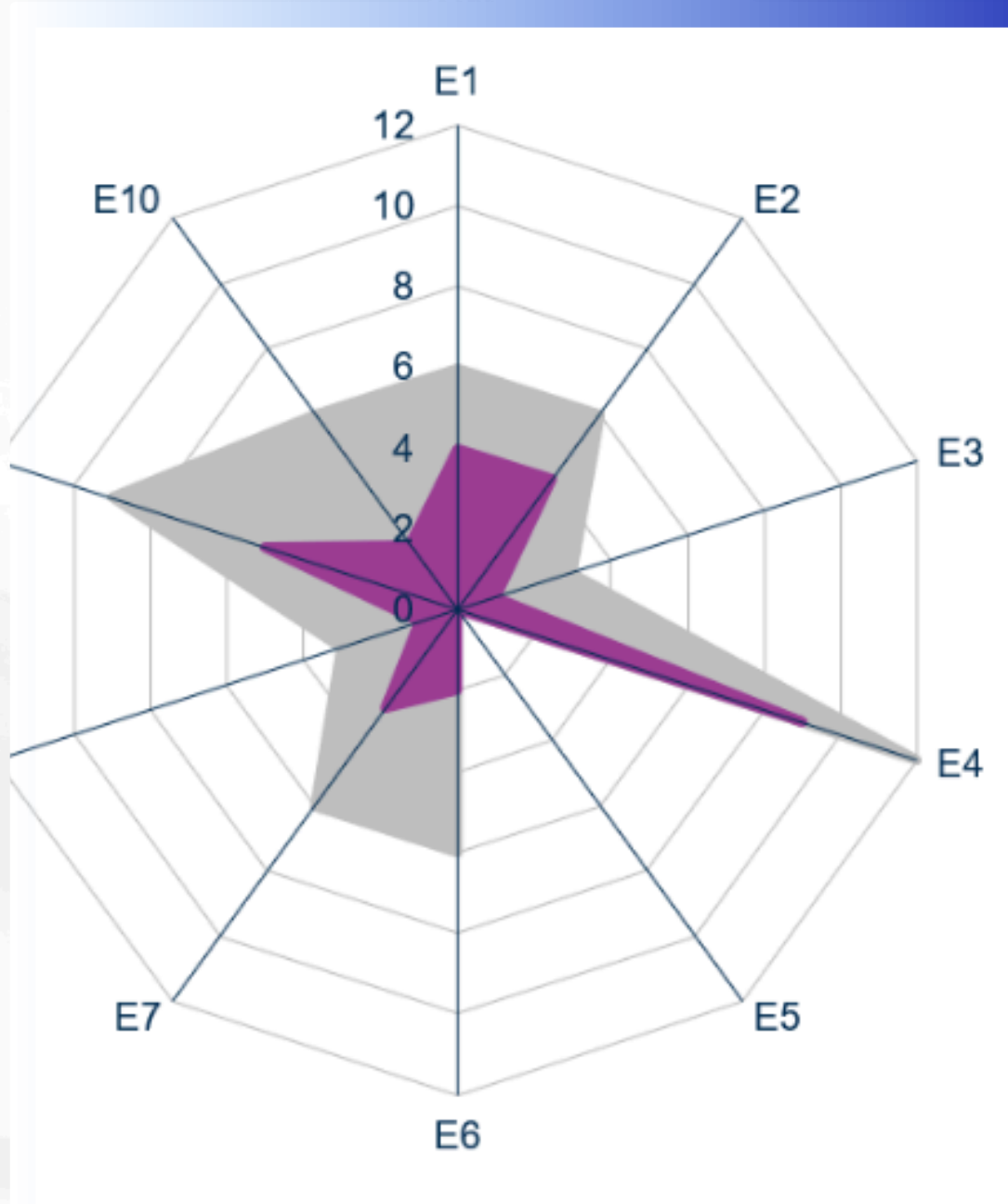

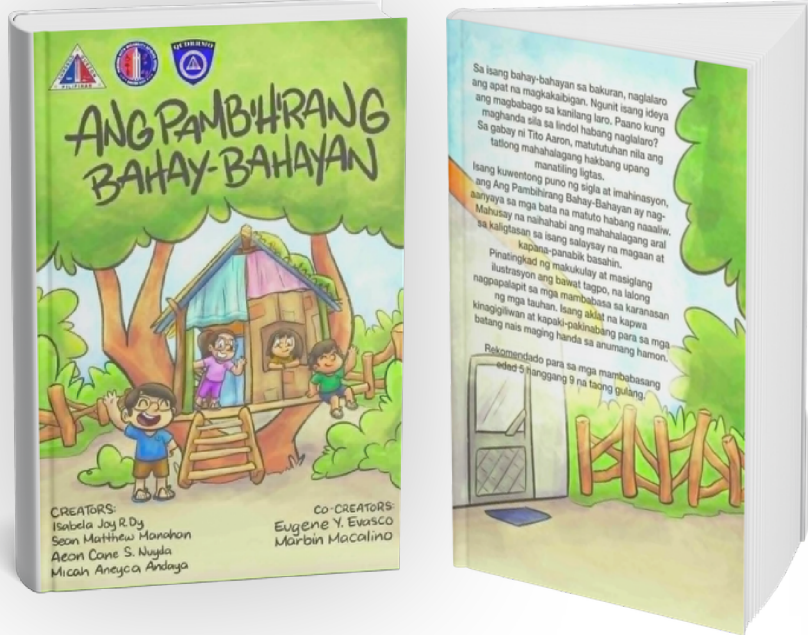
