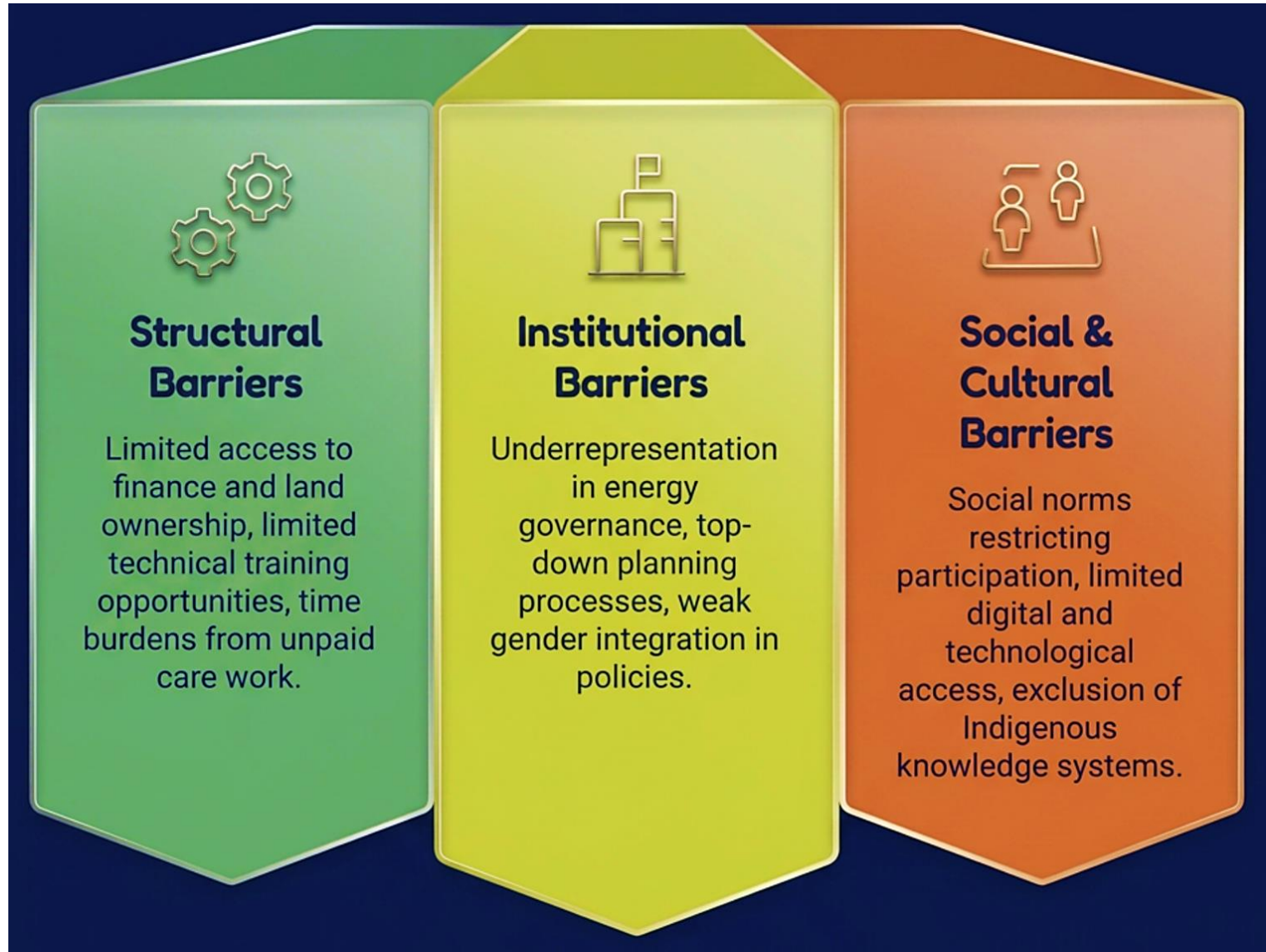

Barriers Faced by Women and Marginalized Groups

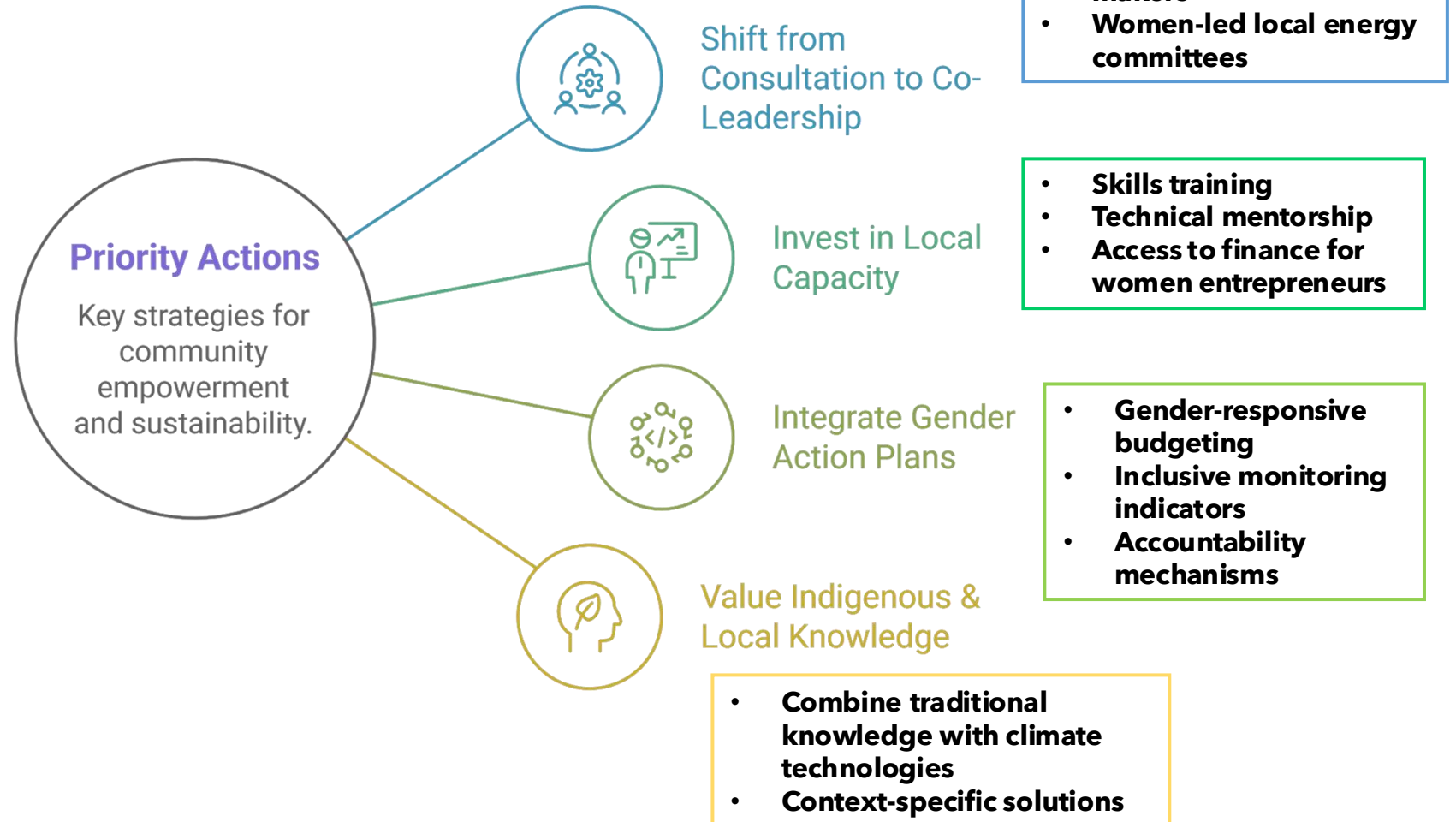
