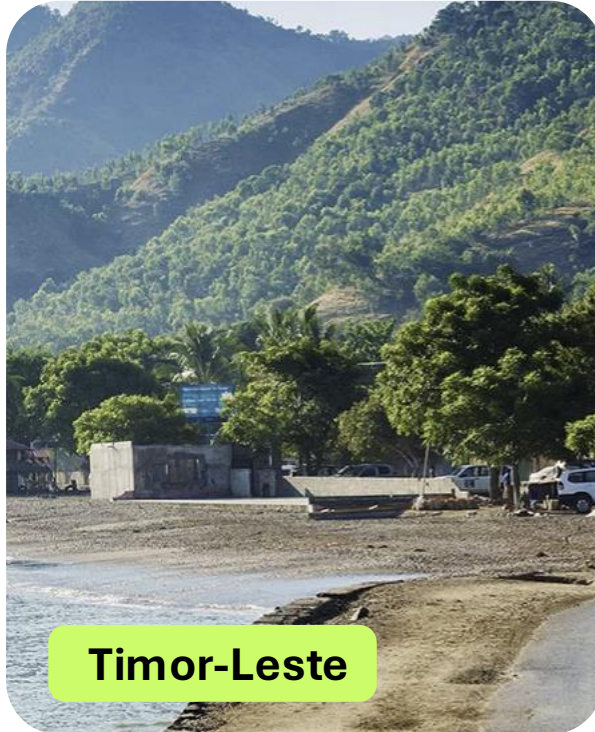

Access Type for Country Support Modality

Option 1

Direct access by a country through the NDA or other competent government ministry or agency

Option 2

Access by a country through an **entity nominated by the NDA**, which can be a national entity; an entity that has entered into a Readiness Framework Agreement with the GCF; or a GCF accredited entity

Option 3

Access by a country through a competitive tender process involving **GCF pre-qualified delivery partner** based on the selection of the best technical and financial offers

Option 4

A **hybrid approach** that combines any of the above methods

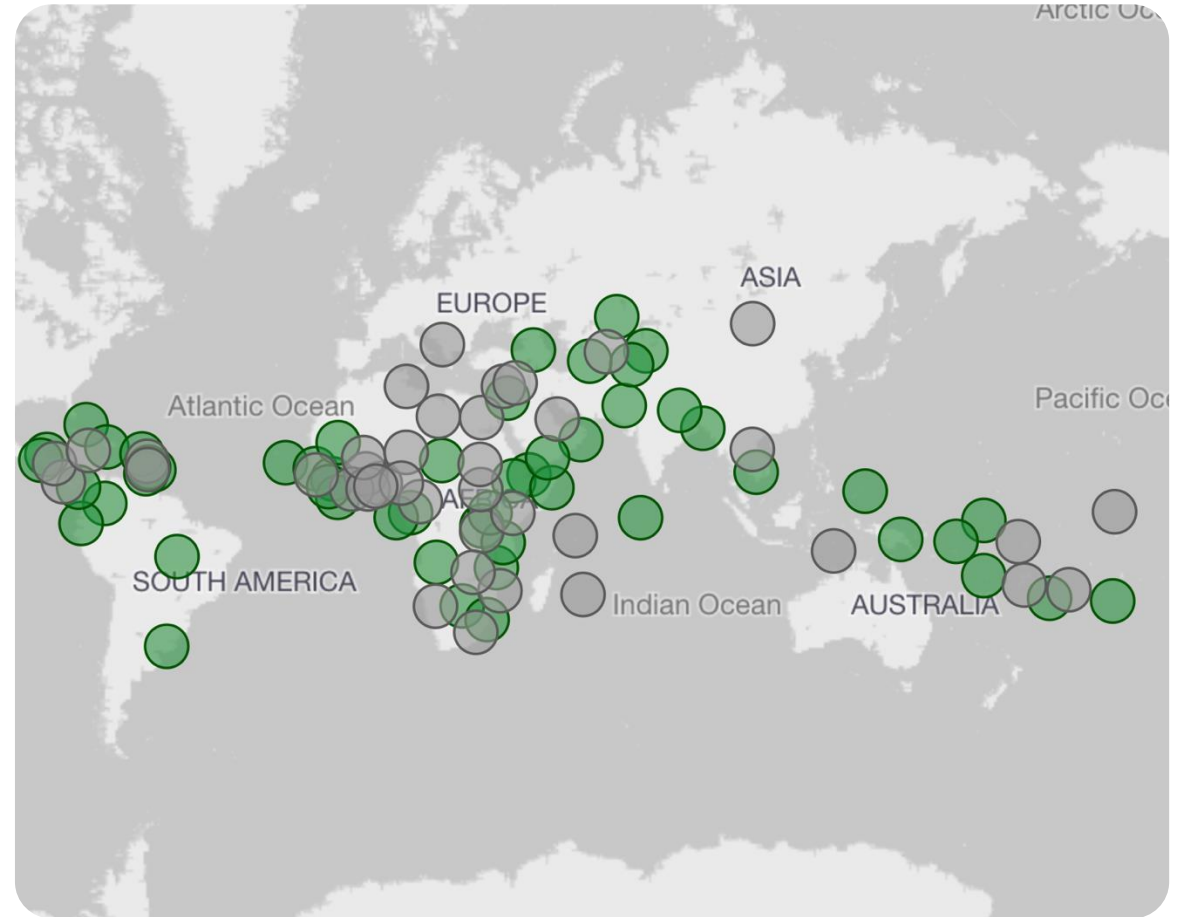

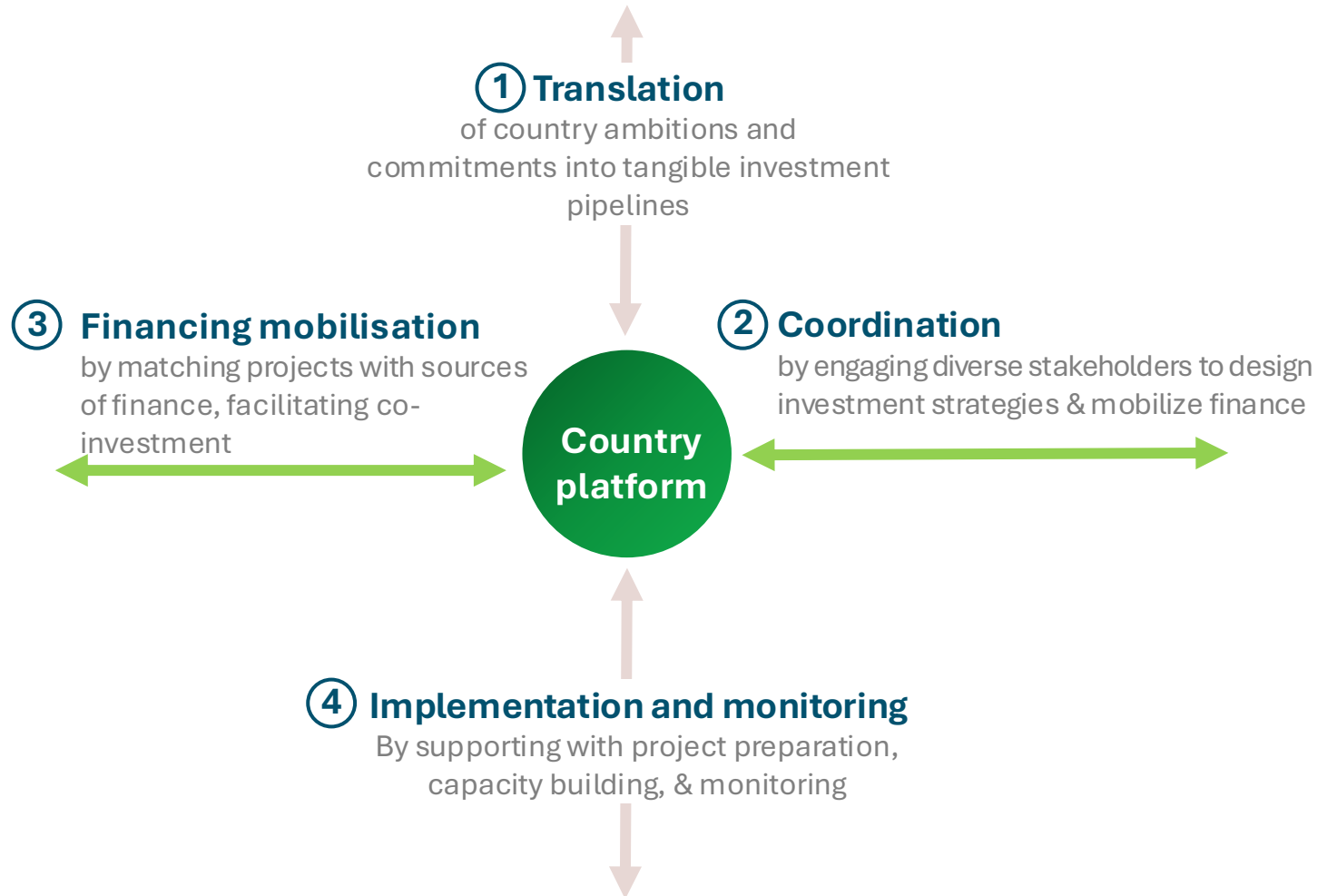

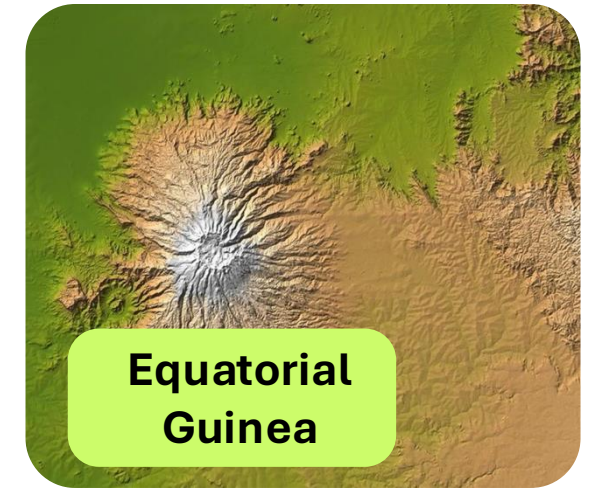
What are Country Platforms?

Brazil

Brazil Climate & Ecological Transformation Investment Platform

The Brazil Investment Platform (BIP) brings together projects, financiers, government institutions, and private sector stakeholders to accelerate investment in Brazil's climate transition. Established to address fragmented project pipelines, limited institutional capacity, and insufficient private sector engagement, the platform focuses on key sectors including nature-based solutions and the bioeconomy, industry and mobility, and energy.

Through GCF Readiness support, a dedicated BIP Secretariat is being established to strengthen governance, stakeholder coordination, and pipeline development, enabling the platform to mobilize climate finance at scale and support Brazil's goal of achieving net-zero emissions by 2050.

Dominican Republic

Dominican Republic's Country Platform – Strengthening institutional capacity and developing an investment pipeline to advance the NDC and strategic climate frameworks

The initiative will enhance coordination among key stakeholders, build capacity for GCF accreditation, develop a prioritized climate investment pipeline, and improve climate finance monitoring and data systems to support NDC implementation.

Upon completion, two national financial institutions are expected to be ready for GCF accreditation and able to channel climate finance through a pipeline coordinated by the Country Platform, laying the foundation for sustained access to climate finance and scaled-up climate action.

Oman

Building Oman's Climate Finance Platform for Effective Institutional Coordination and Investment Mobilization

Readiness will support the establishment and operationalization of the Country Platform, anchored within the NDA and supported by a dedicated Country Platform Coordination Unit, as the central mechanism for climate finance governance, stakeholder coordination, investment pipeline development, and engagement with the GCF.

It will strengthen institutional capacity, bring together government, private sector, civil society, academia, and development partners under a common platform, and develop a Climate Investment Plan and Financing Framework aligned with Oman's NDC, NAP, Net Zero 2050 Strategy, and Vision 2040.
