

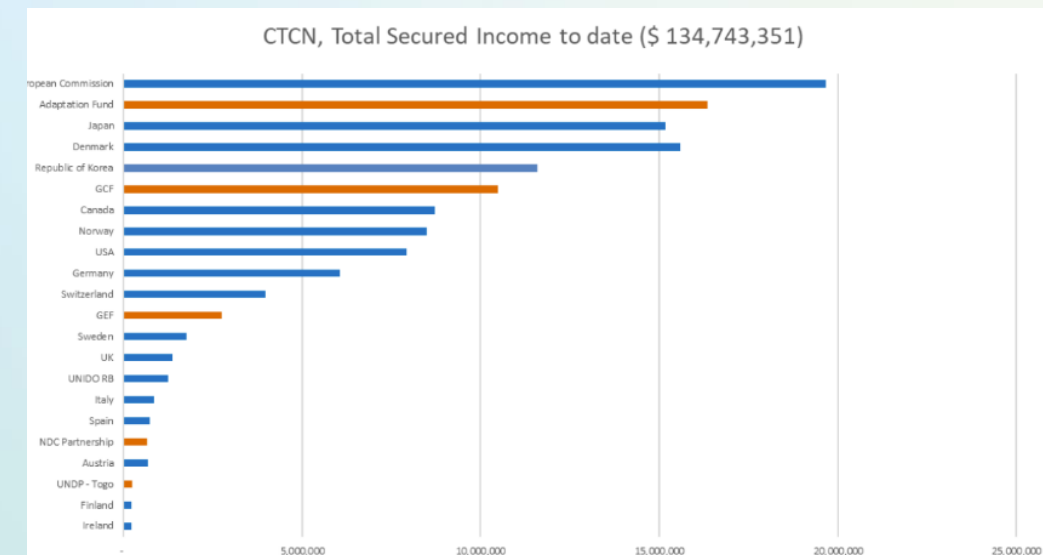

Strategic Action 1: Sustain, strengthen and diversify engagement with donor countries

- Funding received from AF, Canada, EC, Japan, Spain, UNIDO during the JAR reporting period
- Outreach to new and historic donors: Australia, Norway, UK
- Discussions with EC, Germany, Denmark and Canada on funding for 4th PoW
- Stakeholder engagements for 4th PoW will start beginning of 2027 – good time for traditional donors to share how they see CTCN moving forward



Strategic Action 2: Enhance and diversify engagement with development financing sources and international financial institutions

- A USD \$ 96.6 million GCF full project proposal was approved in March 2026 after a KCB and CTCN co-developed concept note was approved for GCF PPF in November 2024.
- A co-financed TA with AfDB will kick off the first ever parametric agricultural insurance product in the country
- Proposals were submitted to the Mitigation Action Facility and preparations were made to submit to a China Aid funding window
- Proposal is being prepared for AF for a scale-up programme
- 5 Implementing Partners from the EC CC&S programme were invited and 2 (Nigeria & CAR) are preparing submission for the GEF small grants programme
- Continuing discussions with AIIB, ADB, EBRD, EDB, NDB to find entry points for collaboration

- Concept note to NNF with decision expected in October
- Outreach to various foundations (including Rockefeller Foundation, CMK Foundation, and ClimateWorks Foundation) and private sector (Orange in Burkina Faso for example)
- UNFCCC Philanthropy Roundtable for TM at New York Climate Week on 22 September

- Discussion with Sweden via Swedish AB member on concept note for dedicated programme
- Introduction by Canadian AB member to Canadian Trade Commission and the Breakout Agenda on Cement and Concrete
- Introduction by AB Chair to Just Transition focal point at ClimateWorks Foundation
- EC DG Clima will provide top-up to three TAs (Kenya, Maldives, Senegal) in the EC ICS programme for post-TA scale up activities



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
