Matchmaking activities

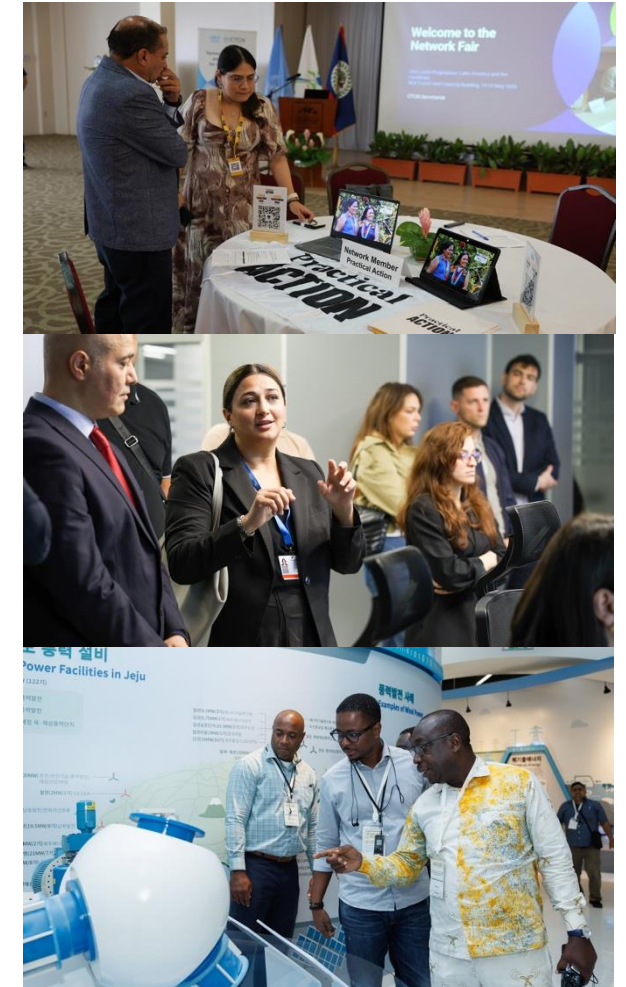
CTCN initiated matchmaking activities alongside the regional NDE Forums, connecting NDEs with Network members and other relevant climate technology providers.

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Increasing access to finance

- **Pakistan's** NDC roadmap for water and waste sectors developed under CTCN TA led to **GGGI-backed biochar studies** in Punjab and development of a national Biochar Accelerator Programme.
- In **Burundi**, the project will test the country's first-ever parametric agricultural insurance product with the African Development Bank
- In **Burkina Faso** the TA project led to collaboration with private company Orange



Looking ahead

- Collaborate with the TEC through regional dialogue(s)
- Coordinate with the TEC through in the development of the second **Joint Programme of Work (JPW)** to ensure the BTIP elements are incorporated
- Joint **resource mobilization** and explore potential **collaborations with the various actors** to support the implementation of the BTIP.
