The Secretariat provided context on the establishment of the taskforce and outlined proposed adjustments to the eligibility, balancing, and prioritization principles within the criteria for technical assistance. Consensus on the revised criteria could not be reached during the Board meeting. Consequently, the Board requested that the taskforce continue its work to refine and finalize the criteria.
