# Importance of Network

## Architecture : Annex VII - TOR of the CTCN – Decision 2 CP17

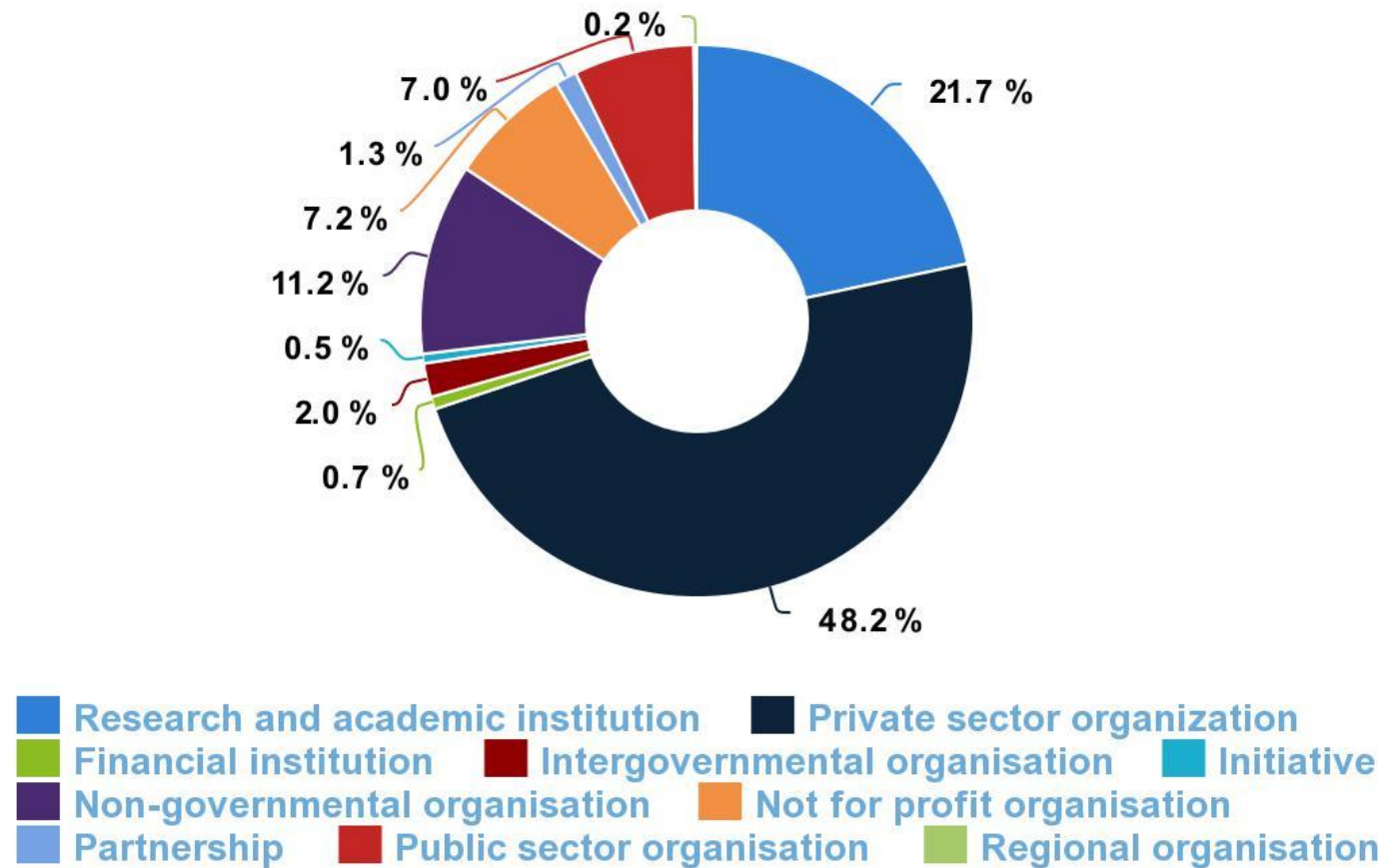
The Climate Technology Centre and Network will consist of the following:

- (a) A Climate Technology Centre;
- (b) A Network with the participation of the relevant institutions capable of responding to requests from developing country Parties related to technology development and transfer, including national technology centres and institutions; regional climate technology centres and networks; intergovernmental, international, regional and sectoral organizations, partnerships and initiatives that may contribute to technology deployment and transfer; and research, academic, financial, non-governmental, private-sector and public-sector organizations, partnerships and initiatives.

**Decision 2 CP 17 , Para 139** - *Decides* that the costs associated with the Climate Technology Centre and the mobilization of the services of the Network should be funded from various sources, including the financial mechanism of the Convention, bilateral, multilateral and private-sector channels, philanthropic sources as well as **financial and in-kind contributions** from the host organization and **participants in the Network**;

# Enhancing Engagement with Network Members

- **Moving towards two stage bidding process** – 80% technical and 20% financial weightage ; but upper limit of budget fixed as per the response plan
- Greater Emphasis on **partnership** with local organization.
- Plans for **facilitating partnerships** through CTCN website.
