Copenhagen, Denmark 29-31 August 2017



- GCF B.17 (July 2017) adopted Operational Framework on Complementarity and Coherence
 - Aims to enhance complementarity at activity and programming levels
 - Gives special consideration to strengthening complementarity with the Technology Mechanism (GCF/B.17/08)
- GCF B.18 (October 2017) to consider:
 - Collaborative RD&D (CTCN AB Chair to participate; AB10 item 6b)
 - Elements to further enhance cooperation and coherence with TM
 - Articulated in B.18 document
 - Decision requests formalization via Exchange of Letters

Ongoing engagement with GCF as basis for future collaboration

- 4 CTCN TAs submitted to the GCF Readiness and Preparatory Support Programme (so far)
 - 3 approved:
 - Tonga – Energy Efficiency Master Plan
 - Ghana – Droughts Early Warning and Forecasting System
 - Myanmar – Drought and flood management
 - 1 still under consideration:
 - Palestine – Technology Roadmap



- Strengthened collaboration between National Designated Authorities (NDA) and National Designated Entities (NDE):
 - 4 joint regional meetings of NDAs and NDEs
 - Latin America – December '16;
 - Asia – May '17;
 - Central Asia and East European Countries – June '17;
 - Pacific Islands – July '17
 - Focal Points meetings (including NDAs and NDEs) at sub-regional level:
 - Asia – April '17
 - East Africa – May '17
 - West Africa – September '17

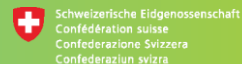
Proposed elements to formalize CTCN/GCF collaboration

- Continued collaboration on CTCN TA via GCF Readiness Programme
- Strengthen CTCN Role as Readiness Delivery Partner through a Partner Work Programme containing proposals for:
 1. Standardized modules for capacity-building, project formulation trainings, and technical assistance
 2. Demand-driven GCF/CTC coordination mechanism
 3. Enhanced NDE/NDA collaboration
