# Request from SBSTA46

- TEC and CTCN invited to provide information on:
  - a) Activities that **have been or are currently being undertaken**, which are relevant for the implementation of the Paris Agreement, taking into account the key themes and their relation to the technology cycle;
  - b) **Additional activities** that the TEC and the CTCN, **subject to available resources**, could undertake within their respective mandates and functions, individually or jointly, to implement the Paris Agreement
- Submissions from AB members received and incorporated
- Joint TEC/CTCN activities include elements from joint chapter of JAR

- a) Ongoing activities organised according to themes of Technology Framework
1. Innovation
  2. Implementation
  3. Enabling Environment and Capacity Building
  4. Collaboration and Stakeholder Engagement
  5. Support

CTCN response based on **concrete activities** with examples from:

- Technical Assistance
- Capacity building
- Knowledge management
- Stakeholder engagement
- Endogenous technologies
- Regional meetings

b) Suggested additional activities include:

- Further collaboration with NDE on NDC implementation, including regional TA requests
  - Strengthen collaboration with GCF and GEF
  - Extend outreach to industrial associations, expanding the skills available to address developing country needs
  - Partnerships to raise awareness and build on complementary strengths of existing services

- Enhanced CTCN awareness at the national level in developed countries will enable access to additional resources including pro-bono support.

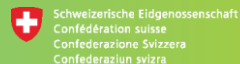
