Capacity-building

Ongoing and planned activities

CB Module for GCF Concept Note development

- To enhance the skills of project proponents in preparing GCF concept notes for submission to the GCF
 - Based on the priorities in the country's climate planning documents (NDC, GCF country programme, TNA, etc.)
 - Implemented by UDP and AIT in Guyana, Tanzania, Zimbabwe and Pakistan
 - Pilot programme funded by CTCN
 - Larger scale programme to be funded by GCF

Ongoing and planned activities (cont.)

2017 Regional Fora

- Organised back-to-back with GCF structured dialogue for Asia, Central Asia and Eastern Europe, Pacific Island Countries
- Caribbean (NDEs and NDAs invited)
- Scheduled in Africa and Latin America

Engagement in the Paris Committee on Capacity Building (PCCB)

- Invited to the first meeting of the PCCB
- Made a submission to the PCCB in response to the call for submissions by the UNFCCC Secretariat on:
 - Capacity-building activities for NDC implementation
 - Suggestions of relevance to PCCB mandate
 - Information and suggestions regarding the web-based capacity-building portal

Ongoing and planned activities (cont.)

Incubator Programme for LDCs

- To develop sector/equipment specific technology roadmaps for NDC implementation
- Programme under implementation in Equatorial Guinea, Mauritania, Senegal and Zambia

Focal points workshop on Mainstreaming Technology in Climate Action Plans

- CTCN NDEs, GCF NDAs, GEF, TNA, NAMA and NAP focal points discuss country priorities and how to strengthen synergies to accelerate technology transfer
- Workshops held in Asia (March 2017) and Anglophone Africa (May 2017)
- Workshops scheduled for Francophone Africa and Latin America in Q4

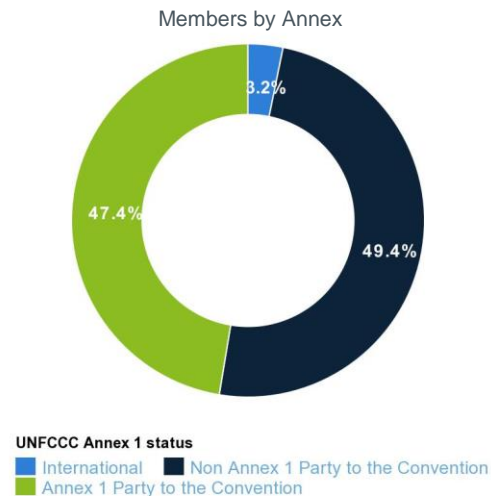
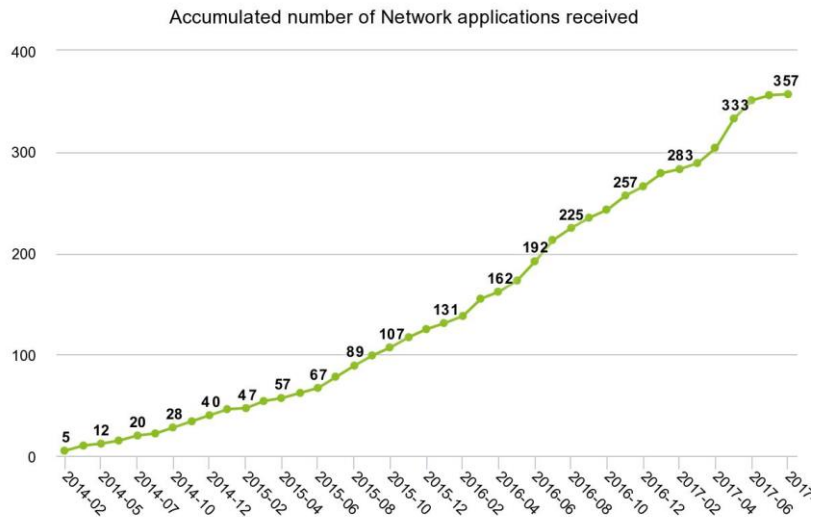

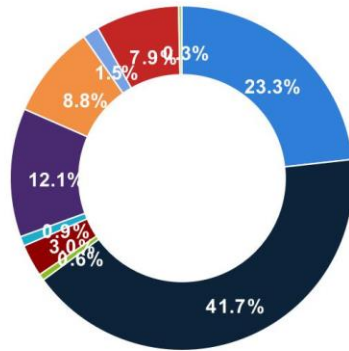

Network status (cont.)

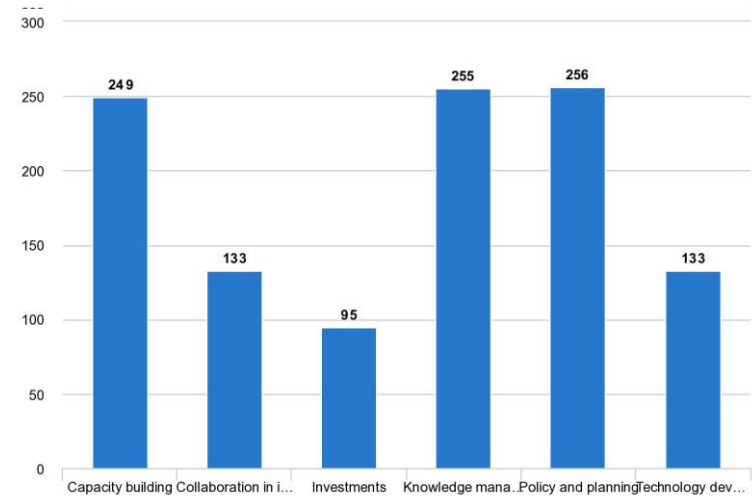
Members by Institution type



Type of organisation

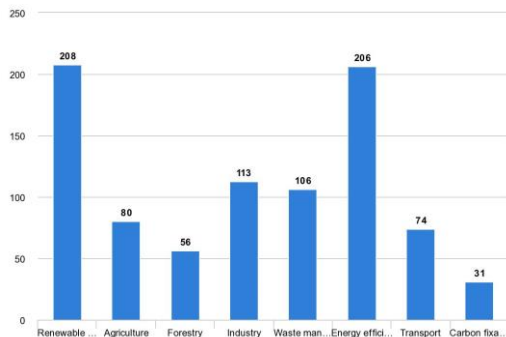

Members by type of service

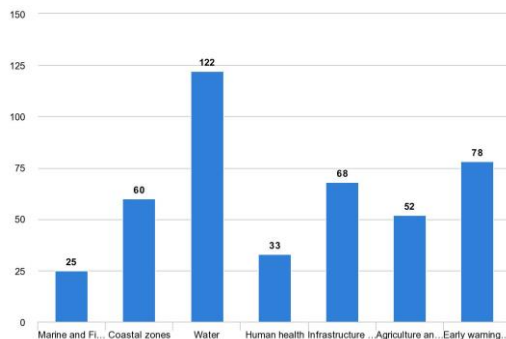

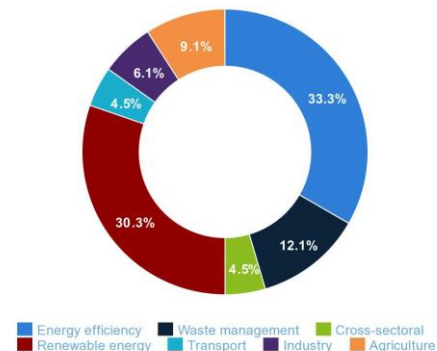
Members by expertise in mitigation sectors



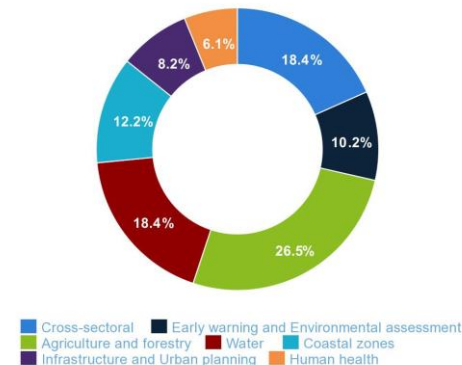
Members by expertise in adaptation sectors



Distribution of requests related to mitigation, by sector



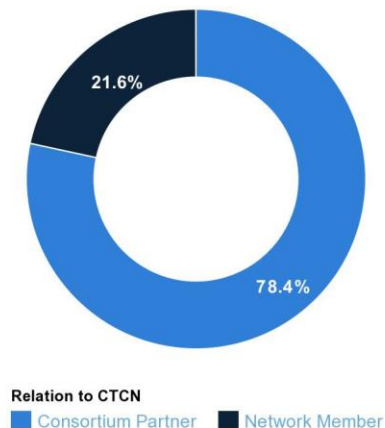
Distribution of requests related to adaptation, by sector



Network engagement

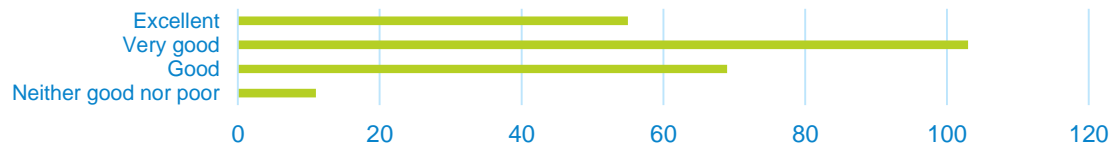
- 20 TA request have been open for bids by NM
- 8 TA bidding opportunities opened for the Network since the last AB
- 83 bids received

- 101 Network members participated in regional NDE forums and CTCN events
- Network members provided 5619 information resources
- 19 Webinars organised by Network members in total with 1023 attendees

Proposed in-kind contribution approach

- Parties envisaged in-kind contributions as a form of financing for the CTCN (2/CP.17)
 - UN Environment bound by a strict definition of ‘contributions in kind’: direct control / ownership by CTC over the resources provided
 - The CTC has received in-kind support in the form of professional services and support staff from host UN Environment and UNIDO and from Consortium Partners
- The CTC accepts pro bono support at all stages of the Technical Assistance
 - Pro bono support is defined as a broader category in a manner that allows for the acceptance and reporting of additional financing, material and expert support that can be provided to the CTCN by donors and other partners.
 - Public and private pro bono support provided during the design phase can be publicly acknowledged by the CTCN. Only public pro bono support provided during the implementation phase can be acknowledged, equal to the value disclosed by the government.
- The CTC will develop policies and procedures to account for additional forms of support, designed to address cases that have been encountered thus far.
- The CTC welcomes any additional input from the Advisory Board in the development of these policies, and will present a review of the policies that have been developed at AB11.

Stakeholder Engagement

Stakeholder Engagement Forums

Focus on enhanced government/private sector matchmaking towards collaborative public/private efforts and identification of Technical Assistance requests.

- Entrepreneurial financing event – Innovate4Water with WIPO – Technical Assistance Namibia in water picked up by private sector for further development
- Planned : Central America (w/ LAC Carbon Forum); Stakeholder Forums – SEA/Mekong;

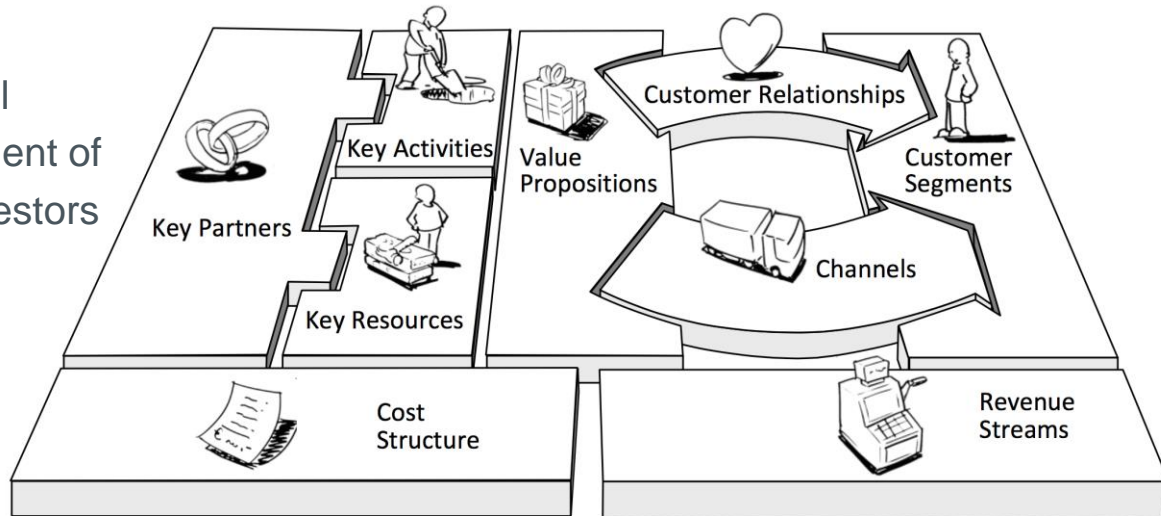
Climate Technology Opportunity Analytics

- Piloting dashboards for Energy opportunity investments in Southern Africa; Water opportunity investments in Central America and Energy efficiency in SEA.
- Creating overview of opportunities for private sector involvement and investment – soft-launch in Mexico in October.

Private Sector Tracking & Response Plan Review

Creation of Business Model Canvases based on private sector opportunities for engagement in selected technical assistances

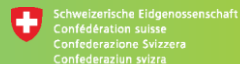
- Initially selected 10 technical assistances – to be used for engagement in Stakeholder/NDE Forums
