### **M&E Framework for Non-Technical Assistance**



Structured in line with related UNFCCC/ COP/ UNEP/ UNIDO/ individual donor requirements guidance to cover:

### Strengthening of collaboration

CTCN stakeholder engagement (including PSE), networking, outreach.

### Capacity building

CTCN incubator programme, webinars, trainings, secondment programme.

### Fostering of knowledge

CTCN engagement with knowledge partners, development of KMS.

### M&E Framework for Non-Technical Assistance cont.



### Ongoing work:

- Implement M&E Framework for Non-TA
  - Check activity and output process indicators (to monitor & assess against timeliness and appropriateness)
  - Collect/Refine outcome performance indicators and refine MoV (to evaluate against effectiveness)
  - Further develop and frame intended impacts to SDGs
- Integrate into internal M&E system review

## Overall M&E Framework (for TA and Non-TA)



#### Current status:

- Full M&E framework now proposed (for both TA and Non-TA)
- Implementation of TA framework is ongoing (see Agenda item 7a)
  - Initial evaluation findings resulted in implementation of improvements to "TA Closure and Data Collection Report template"

### Next steps:

- Finalize implementation of the full M&E framework
- Ongoing monitoring and review of TA and Non-TA activities/outputs
- Internal M&E system review focused on further M&E improvements
