Ongoing and planned CB activities

- **CB module for GCF Concept Note development**
 - To enhance the skills of project proponents in preparing GCF concept notes for future submission to the GCF, based on the project visions identified as priorities in the country's climate change process (NDC, GCF country programme, TNA, etc.)
 - Pilot programme funded by CTCN and implemented by UDP and AIT in Guyana, Tanzania, Zimbabwe and Pakistan
 - Programme to be funded by GCF. Interest from Guatemala and Nepal

- **Incubator Programme for LDCs**
 - To support country actions identified in technology roadmaps to deliver on NDC commitments

Ongoing and planned CB activities (cont.)

- **Country focal point workshop on linking UNFCCC mechanisms and initiatives to accelerate technology transfer**
 - NDEs, GCF NDAs, GEF, TNA, NAMA and NAP focal points discuss country priorities and how to strengthen synergies to accelerate technology transfer
 - Workshop for Asia took place in Bangkok on 17-18 March 2017
 - Workshops scheduled for Africa and Latin America

- **2017 Regional Forums**
 - Organised back-to-back with GCF structured dialogue
 - ✦ Objective: strengthen linkages and enhance NDA/NDE collaboration

- **Invited to attend the first meeting of Paris Committee on Capacity Building**

■ Stakeholder Engagement Forums

- Goal is enhanced government/private sector matchmaking towards collaborative public/private efforts and identification of Technical Assistance requests
 - NDE/SME Entrepreneurial financing experience exchange – Singapore Investment Forum (w/ PFAN, Feb 2017)
 - **Planned** : 3 Stakeholder Forums - Mekong (w/ WIPO); Central America (w/ LAC Carbon Forum); East Africa

■ Climate Technology Opportunity Analytics

- To improve the information and understanding of selected climate technologies and potential benefits and opportunities for private sector involvement and investment. (technology identification through NDC analysis and market assessments).

Stakeholder Engagement – Ongoing and Planned Activities

- **Private Sector Tracking & Response Plan Review In CTCN Technical Assistance**
 - Review Technical Assistance portfolio and identify opportunities to improve response plans and implement suggestions that strengthen private sector engagement

- **Public/Private Partnership Development and Technical Assistance Implementation**
 - To support CTCN in response plan implementation of selected Technical Assistance specifically suited for DNV GL (private sector) competence and expertise
 - To monitor and identify opportunities for development of public / private partnerships.
 - e.g. WBCSD and UN Global Compact partner firms engage via regional/sectoral groups that enable cooperation with local/in-country private sector
