

- General Structural Repairs: External walls - major crack repair
- Extreme Weather Resistance
 Roof cover and fastening upgrades
 Replace windows and frames
 Replace doors and frames
- On-site electricity supply and storage

Rooftop or local ground mount PV Li battery bank

- Off-site emergency power and supplies
- Storm water drainage
 Storm water drainage upgrade
 Roof guttering repair or replacement
