The Genesis of the CTCN intervention

- ✦ As NDE,
- ✦ Assess the compliance of the request with the national policies.
- ✦ Support the proponent during the response plan review and implementation.
- ✦ Assist the consultant and facilitate his work
- ✦ Projects' ideas exist : NAPA, National Environmental Investment Plan (NEIP) and recently to INDC.
- ✦ Guinea has a limited capacity to absorb climate & adaptation funds
- ✦ Lack of local expertise in project development and funds raising.
- ✦ During implementation, the assistance identified project's ideas from the NAPA, NEIP and INDC, all nationally adopted tools.
- ✦ Representatives from main Ministries involved
- ✦ The technology transfer = Transfer of knowledges;

The intended impacts of the technical assistance

- ✦ Representatives from different ministerial departments, research centres, civil society organizations and private sector involved
- ✦ A momentum of continual collaboration for projects development created
- ✦ Five (5) robust concept notes developed, participatory, leadership from the Ministry of Environment,
- ✦ Concept notes presented during the finance round table by those who developed them.
- ✦ Synergy created between different departments
- ✦ Different funds and technical interested in supporting the next steps of these projects (AF, GCF, UNIDO, Bilaterals...)
- ✦ \$150,000 was disbursed for the assistance
- ✦ A good number of women involved

Follow-up activities

- ✦ Collaboration with CTCN for GCF and AF concept notes development
- ✦ Presidency of the Republic Big Projects Department interested in supporting one project
- ✦ Bilateral cooperation also interested through Ministry of Planning
- ✦ Collaboration between organizations champions for the future implementation of projects

Lessons learned

- ✦ The Response Plan development very interactive and helped translating the objectives of the Request into actions.
- ✦ Stakeholders engagement' and potential projects identification by the consultant was very good.
- ✦ Representatives involved from different ministerial departments, research centres, civil society organizations and private sector
- ✦ A momentum created for continual collaboration for projects development.
- ✦ Teams motivated during the implementation and synergy also created between the departments
- ✦ The implementing consultant motivated
- ✦ Most importantly, the motivation of the END and the support from the Ministry of Environment
- ✦ **The limited time was identified as the main reason for not meeting all the objectives of the response.**



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
