Technology Executive Committee Outcomes 17th meeting TEC

- At TEC 17 (25-28 September 2018), TEC continued to implement its 2016-2018 workplan
- TEC workplan activities, include those related to:
 - COP mandates from Paris
 - Six climate technology thematic areas
- For many of its activities the TEC has collaborated closely with the CTCN
- TEC 18 tentatively scheduled for 18-20 March 2019

1. Workplan: key activities

Adaptation technologies

- TEC agreed on a publication on potential application of South-South and triangular cooperation on adaptation and mitigation technologies to assist countries in implementing their NDCs and NAP, which will be launched at COP 24
- TEC agreed on key messages to COP 24 on South-South and triangular cooperation

Climate technology financing

- TEC agreed on its inputs to Standing Committee on Finance for draft guidance to the operating entities of the Financial Mechanism
- TEC agreed to initiate the evaluation of the GEF Poznan strategic programme on technology transfer with a view to enhance the effectiveness of the Technology Mechanism



1. Workplan: key activities (cont.)

Emerging and cross-cutting issues

- TEC has explored elements and features of endogenous capacities and technologies and ways to develop and enhance them, by considering the findings of the survey of NDEs and relevant stakeholders as well as inputs from other bodies
- TEC agreed to publish a summary report to deliver these findings to Parties and relevant bodies, institutions and stakeholders

Innovation and research, development and demonstration

- TEC agreed on the publication of a policy brief on Energizing entrepreneurs to tackle climate change, which will be launched at COP 24
- TEC agreed on key messages to COP 24 on climate technology entrepreneurship



1. Workplan: key activities (cont.)

Mitigation technologies

- TEC acknowledged its enhanced engagement in the technical examination process on mitigation and its participation to the regional technical expert meeting (TEM) in Africa, Asia Pacific, Latin America and the Caribbean
- TEC agreed on recommendations on ways forward and actions to be taken based on the outcomes of the TEMs on mitigation, responding to relevant COP mandates under decision 13/CP.23

Technology needs assessments


- The TEC concluded its work on a paper on how Parties could align their TNAs with the process to formulate and implement NAPs, developed together with the Adaptation Committee, the LDC Expert Group and the CTCN
- Agreed on key messages to COP 24 on technology needs assessments



2. Areas of collaboration with CTCN

Technology research, development and demonstration

- TEC hold a thematic dialogue on climate technology incubators and accelerators at TEC 16 co-hosted by GCF and CTCN
- Based on the findings which emerged from the dialogue, the TEC, in collaboration with the CTCN and the GCF, prepared two documents:
 - a) Summary: Catalyzing financing for climate technology incubators and accelerators
 - b) Report: Promoting Climate Technology Entrepreneurship Through Incubators and Accelerators.
- CTCN AB members and CTCN staff participated in TEC task force on innovation and RD&D



2. Areas of collaboration with CTCN (cont.)

Mitigation technologies

- TEC collaborated with the CTCN in organizing regional TEMs on industrial energy efficiency and on industrial waste-to-energy and circular economy

Technology needs assessments

- TEC continued working with CTCN, Adaptation Committee and LDC Expert Group on considering how countries could align their TNAs with NAPs.



Technology Mechanism

- The TEC and CTCN continued to work to strengthen the linkages between the Technology Mechanism and the Financial Mechanism, including through the participation of their Chairs in the GCF annual meeting with the UNFCCC thematic bodies

Conclusion

- The TEC continues to implement its 2016-2018 workplan, including through close collaboration with the CTCN
- We look forward to continuing to work together to:
 - a) respond to COP guidance and support the implementation of the Paris Agreement
 - b) support the implementation of technology elements of NDCs and NAPs
 - c) enhance collaboration with Parties and other relevant stakeholders
