Delivering on the COP Mandate: Implementation of the CTCN + three core services



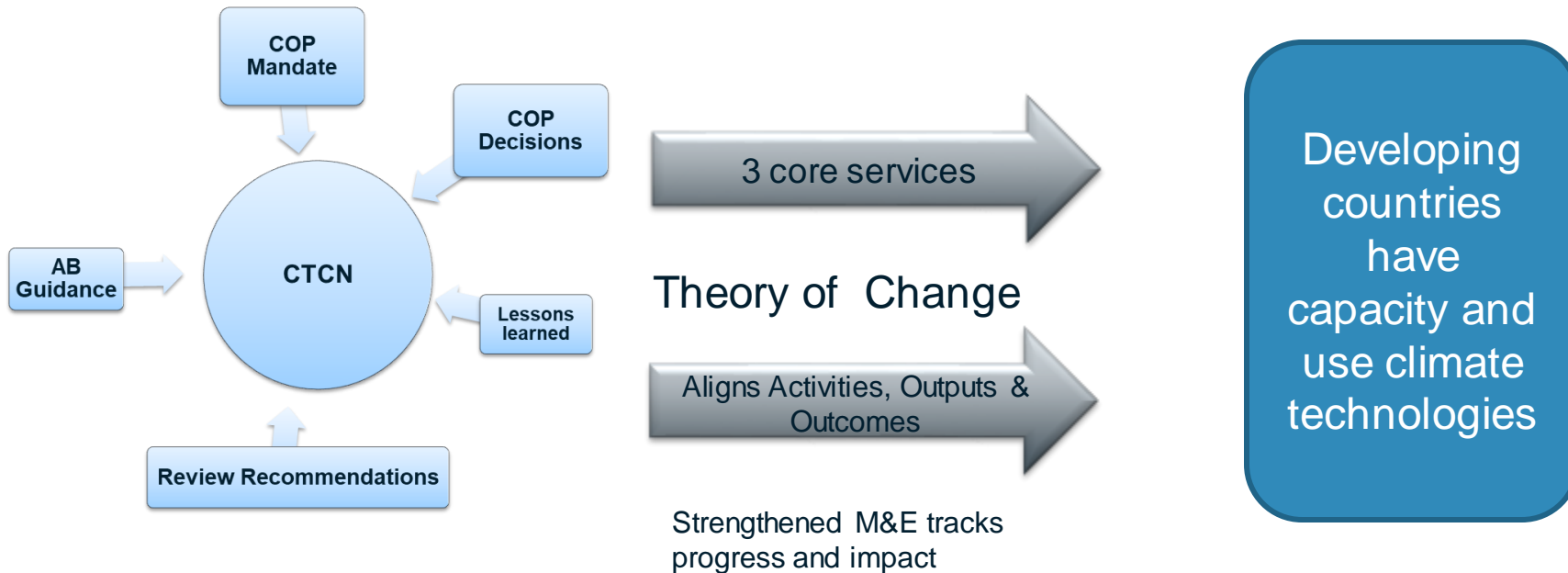
2017: Independent Review; host MOU renewed

Theory of Change (TOC) links COP mandate with target outcome: Developing countries access and use technology



Theory of Change:

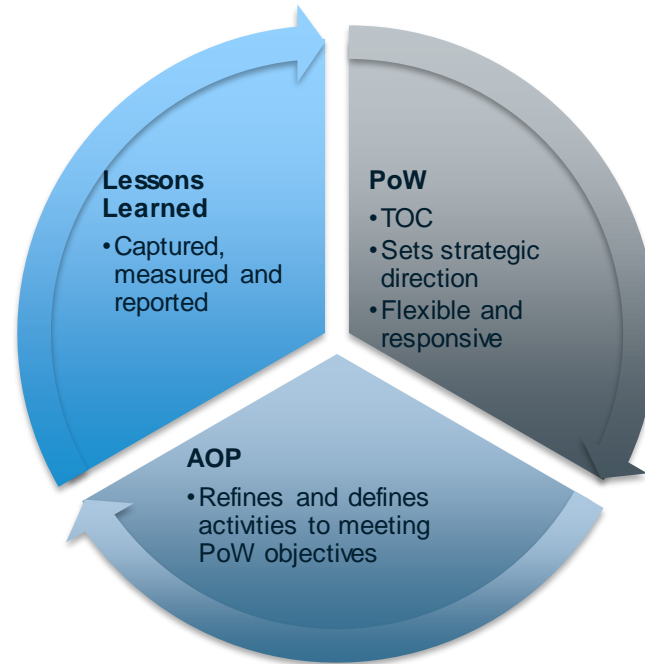
- Identifies long-term and intermediate goals
- Links the first PoW with the second through CTCN core services
- Indicative and iterative process; helps define CTCN niche

Programme of Work:

- Takes priorities identified through TOC, aligns PoW with host agency Project Documents
- Turns targets and indicators from TOC into strengthened M&E for CTC activities, carried out through Annual Operating Plans
- Supports strengthened planning, tracking and reporting of impact

Draft represents CTC's notional framework to guide CTCN over next four years
