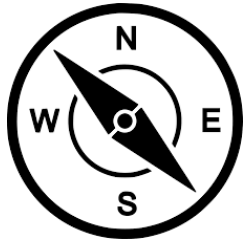

TECHNOLOGY FRAMEWORK in a snapshot



Purpose: Overarching guidance to the work of the TEC and the CTCN in support of the Paris Agreement



5 Principles: Coherence, inclusiveness, results-oriented approach, transformational approach and transparency



5 Key themes: Innovation, implementation, enabling environment and capacity-building, collaboration and stakeholder engagement, support

Example of guidance on Innovation

- **Rationale:** accelerating, encouraging and enabling innovation is critical for an effective, long-term global response to climate change
- **Aim:** accelerate and scale up innovation at different stages of the technology cycle
- **Ways** to achieve the aim:
 - new collaborative approaches to RD&D;
 - enabling policy to incentivize and nurture a supportive environment for innovation;
 - active engagement of the private sector and public and private sector collaboration
- **Actions by TM** around:
 - National Systems of innovation
 - Accelerating existing innovative techs
 - International partnerships on RD&D
 - Private sector engagement in new & innovative techs



Example of guidance on Support

- **Rationale:** Article 10, para 6
- **Aim:** support broader than just financial support, support for all key themes
- **Ways** to achieve the aim:
 - Various type of support
 - Different sources
 - Monitoring and evaluation can enhance effectiveness
- **Actions by TM** around:
 - Collaboration tech Mech – Financial Mech
 - Promoting innovative finance and investment
 - Enhanced technical support for all key themes
 - Mobilization of resources – in-kind & pro bono
 - Monitoring & tracking of actions and support received by TM



Periodic assessment of Technology Mechanism

On two main elements

- effectiveness of and adequacy of support provided to Technology Mechanism

Scope

- On **effectiveness**: contribution to long-term vision, implementation of TNA and technology element in NDC, response to Tech framework guidance, etc.
- On **adequacy of support**: sources, types, level, etc.

Modalities

- By CMA, discussed under SBI
- Every 5 years, the first one 2021 (CMA 4)



Linkages Tech Mechanism - Financial Mechanism

- Invitation to the CTCN and GCF to continue enhancing collaboration, wherein the services and expertise of the CTCN can be used **to strengthen proposals seeking support under the Readiness and Preparatory Support Programme of the GCF**;
- Invitation to developing country Parties to seek support from the CTCN to **develop and submit technology-related projects**, including those resulting from TNAs and from the technical assistance of the CTCN, **to the operating entities of the Financial Mechanism for implementation.**
