Please also note that the technical assistance provided by the CTCN is up to a maximum value of **US \$ 250,000 only** (which would be determined during the next stage during the development of concept notes). Further, the **technology hardware component should not be more than 10-15%** of the total cost of the project.

Please revert to us with your agreement to the above-mentioned statements. Upon receipt of your confirmation we shall move forward with the development of the Concept note.
